Came in with variable winds
& plenty of rain Sch heading
to Eastward under short sail
Middle & latter parts brisk breezes from
South latter part Sch steering East
under three lower sails & Tysail.
Spoke Sch George Racer

Came in with brisk breezes
from South Sch steering East
at sundown shortened sail to two
reefed foresail & Tysail Sch h to S E
latter part brisk breeze from South, Sch
steering E by S

Came in with variable
winds, squalls & heavy rains
at 1 h steered N Saw a steam
ship & Merchant Bark, at 5 h
put two reefs in foresail, Jib down
latter part made sail took a heavy
squall from Westward shortened sail
again to a tynsail double reefed foresail
& Jib

Sunday June 28th

Came in with light air from
S W Sch h to N W under short
sail Middle & latter part calm
Saw Porpoises Grampuses Sharks & dolphin
Employed repairing the foresail

Monday 29th

first part a still calm
Saw Grampuses Sharks Albicors & dolphin
Middle & latter parts light breezes from
E S E Sch steering West under all sail
Spoke Bark Phoenix of Pitou bound
to London

Tuesday 30th

Came in with light breezes from
S E Sch steering N W several vessels
in sight "Merchantmen" at 6 h veered
round to S W Middle part Sch under
short sail latter part fine pleasant
weather at noon spoke Sch Emporium
