

Log of Whaling Schr. *Ellie* of Putnam

Monday August 3^d

Foggy & unpleasant weather
Scraped the booms & painted the deck
outside & middle & latter parts foggy
at 23h got under way & proceeded
to Eastward through the Sound

Tuesday August 4th

Came in with foggy weather
& moderate breezes from South
at 8 45 passed the Pollock Ripps light
Ship, unrigged the boats cleaned the
craft & stowed it away

Mid. part calm with thick fog & rain
latter part foggy with light rain.

at 22 hrs came to an anchor in the
harbor of Provincetown with Starboard
Anchor, veered to 35 fathoms & furled
the sails, thus ends the first voyage
of the *Ellie* of Putnam, 250 sperm.
