Sunday December 1st

First part of day & some fresh breeze from the C. S. C. with passing rain. Squalls middle part pleasant weather and a fresh breeze from the S. S. C. saw several merchant vessels bound to the Westward at 6 P.M. took in the mainsail and set the topsail steering South so ends

Lat 19-42 Long 39-34

Tuesday 2nd. First part of day & some fresh breeze from the S. C. at 5 A.M. took in the topsail and set the mainsail at 2 P.M. and again took in the mainsail with passing rain. At 5 P.M. took in the mainsail and set the topsail so ends steering South

Lat 17-33 Long 38-54

Wednesday 3rd. Begins with pleasant and a light breeze from the C. S. C. middle & last part fresh breeze & pleasant at 6 A.M. set the mainsail and fly jib at 5 P.M. took in the mainsail and set the topsail steering South so ends

Lat 15-04 Long 37-31

Friday 5th. Begins with pleasant weather and a light breeze from the C. S. C. at 7 A.M. saw a school of black fish gun to the windward. Quacks did not shoot. At 6 P.M. set the mainsail and at 8 P.M. took in the mainsail and set the topsail and two reefs. The topsail brought to heading to the S. C. so ends

Saturday 6th. All time & some fresh breeze from the C. and pleasant weather at 6 A.M. took the Key out of the topsail and set the fly jib saw a School Steaming in the S. W. at 6 P.M. took in the fly jib and two reefs the topsail and C. so ends

Lat 10-51 Long 38-58

Sunday 7th. Begins with pleasant weather and a light breeze from the C. S. C. at 7 A.M. took in the topsail and set the mainsail and last part fresh breeze and pleasant. All day under topsail & mainsail & fly jib so ends

Lat 10-42 Long 38-45

Monday 8th. First part of day & some fresh breeze from the C. S. C. and pleasant weather at 6 A.M. took the Key out of the topsail & set the fly jib. Middle & last part moderate at 6 P.M. took in the topsail and reefed it and brought to heading to the North so ends

Lat 10-49 Long 40-00

Tuesday 9th. All time & some pleasant weather & a light breeze from the C. S. C. at 6 A.M. took in the fly jib & shook the Key out of the topsail. More ships and heard to the S. C. later. Set under the topsail & main. Rising at 6 P.M. took in the fly jib & the Keyed the topsail so ends
