Thursdayth Begins with light Trades and pleasant weather at 10 A.M. voyaged anchor and went out on a cruise saw nothing Middle & last part fresh Trades at 5 P.M. came to anchor so ends

Fridayth First part of these 24 hours fresh Trades and pleasant weather at 7 A.M. voyaged anchor & went out on a cruise saw nothing at 10 A.M. came to anchor Middle & last part fresh Trades with passing rain showers at 2 P.M. the Whaling Scho. Thriver passed bound to Harper Island so ends

Saturdayth First part of these 24 hours pleasant weather & light Trades at 7 A.M. voyaged anchor and went out on a cruise saw nothing Middle and last part fresh Trades at 11 A.M. came to anchor broke out the main top all hands employed on ship Duty so ends

Sundayth Begins with pleasant weather and light Trades all this day lying at anchor at 12 M. the Whaling Scho. O. M. Dyer arrived from St. Vincent last part light Trades and pleasant so ends

Mondayth All these 24 hours Trades and rain lying at anchor at 7 P.M. the Whaling Scho. North Clifford arrived from St. Vincent so ends

Tuesdayth First part of these 24 hours fresh Trades and pleasant weather at 10 A.M. voyaged anchor and went out on a cruise saw one Whale & a school of Black Fish lowered and chased them did not get any thing at 3 P.M. came to anchor so ends

Wednesdayth Begins with pleasant weather and a light breeze at 6 P.M. voyaged anchor and went down to Whim Island to see if our crew were there. Five of the crew left in the night but we could not find them at 7 P.M. came to anchor so ends

Thursdayth Begins with pleasant weather and light Trades night at 7 P.M. voyaged anchor & left harbor for St. Vincent saw Black Fish lowered and chased but did not get any at 6 P.M. arrived in St. Vincent so ends

Fridayth Begins with fresh Trades and squally Middle & last part light Trades and pleasant weather lying at anchor at St. Vincent all hands employed on ship Duty at 6 P.M. the Whaling Scho. G. W. Lewis came in from Barbadoe she had 20 lbs of sperm so ends

Saturdayth Begins with fresh Trades with passing rain showers at 5 A.M. voyaged anchor and went down the harbor and filled water at 4 P.M. finished last part lying at anchor so ends

Sundayth First part of these 24 hours pleasant weather and fresh Trades at 9 A.M. got under way from the watering place at 10 A.M. anchored at St. Vincent last part fresh Trades with passing rain showers so ends
