 First part of day 24 hours light
 Breeze from the S.E. with pleasant
 weather and a heavy sea running from
 the S.E. Middle part of day 24 hours
 moderate and pleasant weather
 at 6 P.M. saw a ship running to
 the N.W. at 8 P.M. saw the
 topsail running under topsail foresail
 & two like so far as

Tuesday 28th First part of day 24 hours
 light Breeze from the S.E.
 and pleasant weather at 2 P.M.
 the wind shifted to the S.W. and
 pleasant weather at 4 P.M. set
 the mainsail & running S.W. last
 part pleasant weather so ends

Wednesday 29th First part of day 24 hours
 from the S.W. at 4 P.M. took
 in the mainsail and set the topsail
 split the foresail took it down
 and cut reefed it and set it
 again middle part pleasant weather
 last part fresh Breeze and a
 heavy sea again heading West.
 middle part topsail cut reefed foresail
 and fish at 4 P.M. a Bole
 passed running to the S.W. cut
 the boats in the upper cross so
 ends

Thursday 30th *Continued*
 First part of day 24 hours light
 Breeze from the S.E. at 7 P.M.
 set the mainsail took in the topsail
 or beat the foresail all sails
 furling in mending & set the
 topsail on the foremast saw in
 the running to the S.W. at 7 P.M.
 beat the topsail and took in the
 mainsail and set the topsail heading
 to the S.E. so ends

Friday 31st First part of day 24 hours light
 breeze from the S.W. and pleasant
 weather at 6 P.M. took in the
 topsail & set the mainsail and
 took out the main boom and
 took a chock end of the
 the oil and coopered it & set
 it down again so ends

Long 73-30 Lat 29-30

Saturday 1st All three 24 hours calm squally
 under topsail & fish Bole and the
 main hole saw Grampuses and
 a Passels Whale on the main line
 the Steamer Boat and went to
 it and caught some fish so ends

Long 74-10 Lat 29-30

Sunday 2nd First part of day 24 hours light
 Breeze from the S.E. and pleasant
 weather at 5 P.M. took in the topsail
 and set the mainsail now S.W.
 middle part calm last part light
 Breeze from the S.E. at 7 P.M. took
 in the mainsail and set the topsail
 so ends
