Monday 28th First part of the 23 hours light breeze from the S.W. and pleasant weather on several whaling vessels all the 23 hours Boiling last part pleasant weather so ends at 8 P.M. finished Boiling

Tuesday 29th First part of the 23 hours light breeze from the S.W. and pleasant weather at 5 A.M. commenced boiling down the Oil at 7 A.M. finished at 7 1/2 A.M. saw the Schooner Rising Sea chasing Whales and the foresail and and gun down & then lowered & hoisted got me into their along side and commenced cutting at 7 P.M. finished at 8 1/2 P.M. and the works again so ends

Thursday July 31st Begins with fresh breeze from the S.W. and pleasant weather all hands employed for skinning down Oil and washing off the Kessel at 7 A.M. finished the fore the Whale Mac's 20 lbs at 3 P.M. and the Foresail at 7 P.M. took for the Mainsail & set the Tysail last part fresh breeze and pleasant weather

Lat 30-20 Long 73-00

Friday 2nd

First part of the 23 hours light breeze from the S.W. and pleasant weather at 5 A.M. set the Mainsail and run in the S.W. from several whaling Schooners spoke the Whaling Brig V. H. Will of Provincetown in Bond and got below at 6 P.M. spoke the Schooner Arizona of Provincetown she had just finished Boiling after the Whale at 7 P.M. took for the Mainsail & set the Tysail so ends

Lat 31-50 Long 73-00

Saturday 3rd

First part of the 23 hours light breeze from the S.W. and pleasant weather at 5 A.M. set the Mainsail and run in the S.W. made & last part light breeze and pleasant saw Blackfish got quick also not low saw several whaling Schooners at 7 P.M. took for the Mainsail & set the Tysail so ends
