Friday 16th Lat 30-30 Long 73-25 Begins with a light breeze from the S.W. and pleasant weather at 5 P.M. commenced cutting the Ship Water for in & Allie B. then came down and spoke saw Middle & last part breeze at 7 P.M. finished cutting off the junk & case along side at 9 P.M. set the masts again & ended

Saturday 17th First part of the 23. Drove fresh breeze from the S.W. with a heavy sea again all hands employed in stowing down Oil & pumping out water last part fresh breeze with a heavy sea again & ended

Sunday 18th Begins with a fresh breeze from the S.W. with a heavy sea Middle & last part more moderate spoke the Ship Abby Bradford of Nantucket & ended
