

Remarks on board on the Coast of Peru  
May 1845

Friday the 2<sup>nd</sup>

First Part light winds & pleasant weather steering  
N by W at 2 P.M. set the studding sails employed  
at various jobs of ships duty saw the land at dark  
the island of St. Lorenzo bearing N by W dist  
10 Leagues several sails in sight steering different courses  
Mid Part lying with the main top sail to the mast  
Lat Part light air &c at 5 A.M. the Captain &  
a boat crew left the ship to go ashore at meridian the  
ship off St. Lorenzo dist 1 league Callao in sight  
so ends this Day

Saturday the 3<sup>rd</sup>

First Part fresh breezes & pleasant weather  
at 2 P.M. got up among the shipping the remainder  
of P.M. backing & filling about the harbour  
Mid Part at 8 the boat came along side hoisted  
her up braced full & stood out of the harbour  
The light winds Lat Part fresh breezes ship heading  
to the Westward several hump back whales in  
sight so ends this Day

Sunday the 4<sup>th</sup>

First Part fresh gales saw black fish  
lowered for them without success at dark veered  
ship heading to the Eastward Mid Part strong  
winds at 10 o'clock took in the main top plane sail  
& took 2 reefs in the fore top sail & one in the  
mizzen Lat Part steering N by E by N so ends this Day  
at 12 doubled the main

Monday the 5<sup>th</sup>

First Part steering N by E by N at one P.M. saw  
the land Mid Part laying off & on Lat Part beating  
into the harbour of Callao so ends this Day

Remarks on Board laying in Callao  
May 1845

Tuesday the 6<sup>th</sup>

First Part at 2 P.M. came to an anchor in the  
Port of Callao &c Mid Part nothing of note Lat Part  
discharged 5 bbls of black fish oil the starboard watch ashore  
on liberty so ends this Day

Wednesday the 7<sup>th</sup>

First Part discharged 50 boxes of candles the watch  
still ashore took on board 14 bbls of Potatoes  
Lat Part the Larboard watch ashore on liberty  
so ends this Day <sup>discharged on bbl</sup>  
<sub>of sperm oil</sub>

Thursday the 8<sup>th</sup>

The Larboard watch ashore took on board 33 bbls  
of Potatoes &c Lat Part 14 more

Friday the 9<sup>th</sup>

First Part all hand on board employed at  
doing nothing Lat Part discharged one bbl of sperm  
oil

Saturday the 10<sup>th</sup>

Friday the first Part took the starboard anchor  
on to the bow rove the fish tackle &c Lat Part  
got the ship clear so ends this Day

Sunday the 11<sup>th</sup>

First Part at 1 P.M. got under weigh  
lay off and on till sundown Mid Part light  
air & calm saw black fish Lat Part light  
winds ships course N by W so ends this Day Lat 12-18

Monday the 12<sup>th</sup>

First Part light winds from the S. E.  
steering W Mid Part the same Lat Part  
steering W by N employed at starting water &c  
so ends this Day in Lat 11-27.
