

Saturday the 7<sup>th</sup> June 1845

Begins with strong breeze & clear weather Employed at cutting in one sail in sight at 6 P.M. lashed down for the night at 2 past 5 A.M. commenced cutting again at 7 raised a school of whales off the lee Bow going to the windward got off two Boats & gave chase but without success returned to the ship finished cutting and made sail on the ship heading to the East So Ends

Sunday the 8<sup>th</sup>

Commences as the following Day at 1 P.M. saw whales again gave chase but without success at 6 P.M. returned on board while Part Employed in Boiling bailing Case cutting junk &c Latter Part Employed in breaking out for Cash So Ends

Monday the 9<sup>th</sup>

Begins with light air and pleasant ship heading to the SW at 4 P.M. raised whales down all of the Boats and got one got him to the ship at 7 P.M. while Latter Part a boiling Ends more whales in sight but going to the windward made preparation for cutting &c

Tuesday the 10<sup>th</sup>

Begins with strong breeze and cloudy at 1 P.M. commenced cutting cut in the Body left the head along side all night while Part a boiling Latter Part finished cutting took in the Fore & Mizzen topsail Double Reefed the main thus Ends

Wednesday the 11<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours strong breeze ship heading NE all hands Employed in boiling bailing Case breaking out for Cash &c

Remarks on board

Thursday the 12<sup>th</sup> June 1845

Strong breeze during the 24 hours ship under easy sail heading NE all hands Employed making preparation for stowing down oil So Ends

Friday the 13<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze as yesterday ship heading the same all hands Employed in stowing down oil & men off of duty So Ends

Lat 3.46 S Long 105.05 West

Saturday the 14<sup>th</sup>

Strong breeze as above with frequent showers of rain ship under easy sail heading NE Employed in stowing down oil So Ends this Day

Lat 3.22 S Long 105.04 W

Sunday the 15<sup>th</sup>

Commences as usual ship heading NE Employed in stowing down Latter Part made sail on the ship all hands Employed in sleeping some in the line tubs So Ends Lat 2.48 S Long 104.50 W

Monday the 16<sup>th</sup>

Employed at sewing down so ends this Day this is the 16<sup>th</sup>

Tuesday the 17<sup>th</sup>

Employed as above so ends this Day

Wednesday the 18<sup>th</sup>

First Part finished stowing down Latter Part employed at washing ship so ends this Day this is the 18<sup>th</sup>

Thursday the 19<sup>th</sup>

Employed at various jobs of ships duty so ends this Day
