

Remarks on Board

June 1845

Friday the 20th

Commences with light winds & pleasant weather Mid & Lat Parts much the same

Lat 4-03

Saturday the 21st

Commences as above ship heading N Lat Part at 8 P.M. saw whales off the weather bow made several tucks to weather them at Meridian whales to the leeward so ends this Day

65 bbls

Sunday the 22^d

First Part at 1 o'clock lowered the boats the larboard boat got fast stove & capsized the bow boat picked up the crew the other boats killed the whale at 4-30 took him to the ship Lat Part cut him in so ends
Lat 6-28

Monday the 23^d

Employed at boiling with a strong breeze so ends this Day in Lat 6-48

Tuesday the 24th

First Part strong winds employed at boiling mid Part the same at 5 o'clock finished washed off deck &c so ends this Day Lat 6-42

Wednesday the 25th

Fresh gales the watch employed at ships duty so ends this Day in Lat 6-36 Long 103-56

Thursday the 26th

The same as above so ends this Day

Remarks on Board

June 1845

Friday the 27th

Commences with fresh gales from E S E with frequent squalls ship heading N E at 5-30 spoke the ship William West of Balbi - Haven 32 months out with 2300 bbls of sperm oil Mid Part strong winds Lat Part much the same all hands employed in stowing down oil so ends this Day

Saturday the 28th

These 24 hours employed as above so ends

Sunday the 29th

Commences with fresh gales and cloudy weather employed as above at 6 P.M. finished stowing down & washed the decks Mid & Lat Parts nothing of note so ends this Day in Lat 7-20

Monday the 30th

First Part fresh gales from S E ship under easy sail heading to the N E Lat Part all hands employed in stowing water in the lower hole so ends this Day
Ship N E

Tuesday the 1st July 1845

First Part employed as above Mid Part squally weather Lat Part employed at various jobs of ships duty so ends this Day in Lat 6-12 Long 103-08

Wednesday the 2^d

First Part light winds with rain squalls ship heading to the Eastward employed in ships duty one ship in sight Mid Part light winds & pleasant weather Lat Part at 9 P.M. saw sperm whales 4 points off the lee bow going to windward some of them went to leeward & part of them went to windward & we sight of all of them so ends this Day in Lat 5-28 South.
