

Remarks on Board

Saturday the 12th July 1845

First Part fresh gales ship heading to the Eastward the watch employed at various jobs of ship's duty Mid & Lat Parts nothing of note so ends this Day Miss H & D

Lat 5-49 South Long 102-10

Sunday the 13th

First Part fresh gales ship heading to the Eastward more ship heading S by W. Middle the same. Latter saw Whales ran for them they proved to be Finbacks Luffed by the wind at Sun-down took in Sail So ends this Day Lat 5-35

Monday the 14th

Commences with fresh gales & ends the same in Lat 5-00 South

Tuesday the 15th

Commences as above Mid Part squally weather ship heading to the Eastward Lat Part at 9 AM squared the yards & kept the ship off steering W by N the watch employed at various jobs of ship's duty so ends this Day in Lat 6-40

Wednesday the 16th

Commences with light winds & pleasant weather steering W by N at sundown shortened sail & luffed to the wind heading W by N Mid Part nothing of note Lat Part at 11 AM saw a break off the le bow kept the ship off so ends this Day

in Lat 5-25 South

Remarks on Board

Thursday the 17th July 1845

First Part running off for the beach at 1 P.M. saw the whales lowered the boats & the starboard boat got fast & turned over at 5-30 took the whale to the ship Mid Part the watches employ in making preparations for cutting Lat Part employed at cutting at Meridian finished so ends this Day Lat 5-08

Friday the 18th

First & mid Parts employed at bailing Lat Part the same so ends this Day Lat 5-50

Saturday the 19th

First & mid Parts employed as above Lat Part at 9 AM finished bailing started water &c so ends this Day Lat 4-58 South

Sunday the 20th

First Part employed at washing ship Mid Part nothing of note Lat Part fresh gales & pleasant weather so ends this Day

Miss H & D Lat 6-20 South Long 102-49 West

Monday the 21st

Nothing of note so ends this Day Lat 5-56

Tuesday the 22nd

Strong gales the watch employed at various jobs of ship's duty put the starboard boat on the cranes & so on so ends this Day no observation
