

Remarks on Board laying in Laysan Sept 1845

Saturday the 27th

First Part at 4-30 came to anchor in Laysan in 5 fathoms of water at 5-30 the Capt. went ashore Mid Part at 9-30 the Capt. came aboard Lat Part the starboard watch ashore on liberty the Larboard watch employed in painting ship so ends this Day

Sunday the 28th

First Part the starboard ashore on liberty the Larboard watch employed in painting ship Lat Part the Larboard watch on liberty so ends this Day

Monday the 29th

First Part the Larboard watch on liberty

Tuesday the 30th

The starboard watch on liberty

October 1845 Wednesday 1st

Thursday the 2^d

The Larboard watch on liberty

Friday the 3^d

First Part the Larboard watch on liberty Lat Part all hands on ships duty

Saturday the 4th

First Part employed in getting on board recruits Lat Part have short and made preparations for sailing so ends this Day

Sunday the 5th

First Part weighed anchor & went to sea Mid & Lat Parts fresh breezes

Remarks on board bound to Rumbey & in Rumbey 82 October 1845

Monday the 6th

First Part the Land in sight spoke the ship Minerva of Edgarton 27 months out with 1100 bbls of sp oil Mid Part & Lat nothing of note so ends this Day

Tuesday the 7th

First Part fresh gales at 3 P.M. spoke the ship Henry of Winterset at 6 anchored in Rumbey Lat Part employed in ships duty rafting water cask &c so ends this Day

Wednesday the 8th

Begins with pleasant weather at 5 the boats returned from watering Mid Part fine weather Lat Part the same at Daylight sent the boats in after water at 10 they returned with 22 cask hoisted in and got Limer & Ends this Day

Thursday the 9th

Begins with strong wind at 2 P.M. weighed anchor and got the ship under way put to sea for a few days under the command of the Mate on account of the Port being shut left the Captain on shore to make arrangements for the Ships return in a few days Mid & Lat Part moderate all hands Employed in stowing down water so Ends

Friday the 11th

These 24 hours moderate Ship under easy sail heading S.E. all hands employed Stowing Down Water Ends Ship heading off Shoar

Saturday the 11th

First Part A fine breeze ship heading N.W. all hands employed in ship duty at dark tacked ship off shore Mid Part at 2 tacked in at daylight kept off N.E. for Rumbey so ends this Day
