December 1845

Wednesday the 17<sup>th</sup>

First Part light winds & pleasant weather ship  
heading to the Eastward the watch employed in  
ship, Duty Lat Part one ship in sight  
so ends this Day Lat 4-28 Long 103-30

Thursday the 18<sup>th</sup>

First Part ship heading to the Eastward at  
sundown tacked ship & shortened sail Mid & Lat  
Part, nothing of note so ends this Day in Lat 5-12

Friday the 19<sup>th</sup>

First Part fresh breezes ship heading to the  
southward at 2 P.M. spoke the ship Abigail of  
New Bedford 24 months out with ~~1050~~ 1050 lbs  
of sperm oil & the Lafayette of New Bedford 15 months  
out with 450 lbs of sperm oil Mid & Lat Parts  
nothing of note so ends this Day in Lat 5-26

Saturday the 20<sup>th</sup>

First Part ship heading to the Southward at sundown  
shortened sail & veered ship Mid & Lat parts nothing  
of note so ends this Day in Lat 5-22  
Long 103-58

Sunday the 21<sup>st</sup>

First Part light winds & pleasant ship heading  
to the Eastward Mid & Lat Parts nothing of  
note so ends this Day Lat 4-19

Monday the 22<sup>nd</sup>

First Part light winds & fine weather ship heading  
to the N.E. Lat Part 3 ships in sight  
so ends this Day in Lat 5-24

Tuesday the 23<sup>rd</sup>

First Part light winds & pleasant weather spoke the  
ship New Bedford 17 months out with 1500 whale &  
200 sperm Lat Part 2 ships in sight so ends this Day  
Lat 4-29

Wednesday the 24<sup>th</sup>

First Part light winds & pleasant ship heading  
to the Southward Mid & Lat Parts the same  
so ends this Day Ship Ab E P in Lat 5-31  
Long 104-06

Thursday the 25<sup>th</sup>

First Part light winds & pleasant weather ship  
heading N by W at sundown shortened sail &  
veered ship Lat Part ship heading to the Eastward  
one sail in sight right so ends this Day in Lat 5-22

Friday the 26<sup>th</sup>

First Part fresh breezes ship heading to the  
Eastward 3 ships in sight Lat Part at 8 P.M. 1/16  
tacked ship saw hawk fish & a finback  
so ends this Day Ship Ab E P in Lat 5-29

Saturday the 27<sup>th</sup>

First Part fresh breezes ship heading to the Southward  
at sundown shortened sail & veered ship Lat Part  
started water so ends this day Lat 4-25

Sunday the 28<sup>th</sup>

Lat 5-14

Monday the 29<sup>th</sup>

First Part fresh breezes ships cours N by W saw  
black fish lowered without success  
Lat 4-50

Tuesday the 30<sup>th</sup>

Lat 4-31
