

Cruising on the.

Wednesday, June 24th 1846

Began with light wind from the S.W. the ship under double reefed top-sails. Employed in breaking out the fore hold for stowing down oil. Middle part moderate. Latter part light wind from the W.N.W. Employed in stowing oil in the fore hold.

Thursday June 25th

Began with light wind. Employed in stowing down oil. One ship in sight, a whaling. Mid & Latter part calm. Employed as above. See Ends. Lat 58° 01' N. Long. 146° 19' West.

Friday, June 26th

Began with a dead calm. Employed in stowing down oil. One ship in sight, boiling, at 6 P.M. lowered the boat without success. Mid part calm. Latter part, calm. Employed in chasing whales. See Ends. Lat 52° 29' N.

Saturday June 27th

Began with light air & calm. At 1 P.M. the boat came on board without success, a bark. to the leeward, at 10 P.M. spoke the Barque Valparaiso of N Bedford Capt. Luce. 11 Mts out with 1700 Bbls whale oil. Lat light wind from the South. the captain on board the Barque.

Sunday June 28th

Began with light air & calm. in company with the Valparaiso. Mid part light wind from the South steering to the North. Lat part chased whales without success.

Monday June 29th

Began with moderate wind from the W.S.W. lowered the boat again for whales get none. at 4 P.M. spoke the Chili of N.B. had got one whale this season. Middle & Latter part heavy.

Tuesday June 30th 1846

Began with light wind from the N.W. at 5 P.M. lowered the boat struck a whale drew the iron and came on board. Spoke the Ship Mobile. had got one whale this season. Middle & Latter part light wind & foggy. Lat 53° 18' North.

Wednesday July 1st

Began with light wind & calm. lowered the boat without success. Middle & Lat part fresh gale from the Eastward. Saw whales going quick. Lat 53° 30' North.

Thursday July 2nd

Began with a strong gale from the E.S.E. and rain. Ship with the fore & mizzen-top sails furl. as Middle & Latter part the same.

Friday July 3rd

Began with strong wind from the Eastward & foggy. Ship lying to as above mentioned. Mid & Latter part light wind from the West. A heavy sea running & thick foggy.

Saturday July 4th

Began as yesterday ended. Ship lying to? Mid & Latter part the same.

Sunday July 5th

Began with light air & calm. at 8 P.M. a strong breeze from the N.W. Middle & Latter part about the same. At 9 A.M. spoke the Ship Lancaster of N.B. had got 4 whales.

Monday July 6th

Began with a moderate wind from the Southward & foggy. at 4 P.M. spoke the Bark Gemini of N.L. had got 4 small whales this season. Middle & Latter part foggy.
