

Port Moresby August 1846

Friday the 14th

Came with calm ship of the harbor 18 ships in the harbor at 5-30 anchored in 14 fathoms of water at 12 the Capt. went ashore &c
Lat Part the starboard watch on liberty took a raft ashore & commenced painting ship so ends

Saturday the 15th

First Part the watch employed in painting ship &c Lat Part the starboard watch ashore on liberty the Larboard watch employed in getting ashore a raft of cask to fill with water & painting ship so ends this Day

Sunday the 16th

First Part the watch employed in painting Lat Part went to church

Monday the 17th

First Part the watch ashore Latter Part the watch employed in painting ship so ends

Tuesday the 18th

First Part one watch ashore a liberty the others employed in drying bone Lat Part the watch employed in bundling bone & took aboard 20 Hls of potatoes so ends

Wednesday the 19

This Day the watch employed as above

Remarks on board at Moresby August 1846

Thursday the 20th

First Part the Larboard watch on liberty the starboard watch shipped 9912 of whale bone on board the barge Mongola of Salepa for home Latter Part the starboard watch on liberty the Larboard watch employed in ships duty so ends

Friday the 21st

First Part one watch employed in stowing water the other on liberty Latter Part the same

Saturday the 22nd

First Part one watch employed in ships duty the other on liberty Latter Part at 10 AM got the ship under way the Capt. & boats crew ashore so ends this day the ship laying off & on

Sunday the 23rd

at 5 PM the Capt. came on board trimmed the sails & stood out to the passage strong breezes & usually split the fore top sail unbraced it double reefed the main & mizen steering W by N at 12 o'clock bore the ship too at daylight Diamond Lead in sight kept away for it at 8 AM hoist a new fore top sail the ship of war in sight laying st. anchor in the outer harbour of Cahu at 10 AM the Capt. & boats crew went ashore the ship laying off & on so ends this Day

Monday the 24th

Came the Capt. ashore ship laying off & on Latter Part the same so ends
