

Remarks on Board bound to the Coast of Chili
September 1846

Sunday the 20th

Commences with light winds from the S & by S ship heading S by W the watch employed in receiving running rigging & various other jobs of ship duty Middle Part light airs from the S & at 9 o'clock tacked ship S W set the royals Lat Past light airs from E S & ship heading S set the top mast & top galant studdensails so ends this Day Ship W & S in Lat 24 04

Monday the 21st

Commences with light airs from the E steering S S E clear pleasant weather Middle Part calms & light air from the S & E Latter Part light airs from the S & the watch employed in various jobs of ships duty so ends this Day Lat 24 26

Tuesday the 22^d

Commences with light airs from the S W ship heading S S E Middle Part strong breezes from the S W took in the fore & mizen top-galant-sails & flying jib Latter Part fresh gales from S S W ship heading S E so ends this Day Lat 25 57 S Long

Wednesday the 23^d

Commences with fresh gales from the S S E ship heading S S E Middle Part set the fore & mizen-top-galant-sails wind from the S E at 8 o'clock tacked ship heading S S W Latter Part strong breezes from E S & ship heading S the watch employed in wetting hole & various other jobs of ships duty took in the fore-top-galant-sails so ends this 24 hours Lat 26 57 Long

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Thursday the 24th

Commences with strong breezes from the E S & ship heading S a heavy sea from the S S E Middle Part strong winds took in the fore-top-galant-sail & mizen Latter Part strong winds from S & by E ship heading south by W the watch employed in repairing a jib so ends this Day Lat 28 03

Friday the 25th

Commences with strong breezes from the S & by E ship heading S by E the watch employed in repairing a jib took in the flying jib Middle Part the ship heading S set the flying jib & mizen top-galant-sail Lat Past strong gales & squally took in the flying jib & mizen top-galant-sail so ends this Day Lat 31 19 south

Saturday the 26th

Commences with strong gales & heavy squalls from the E S & ship heading south took in the main-top-galant-sail sent down the fore Rial yard & mast set the main-top-mast-stay-sail so on the Middle Part set the main-top-galant-sail & flying jib & mizen-top-galant-sails Latter Part fresh breezes from the S & ship heading S W the watch employed in various jobs of ships duty at Parique to the leeward so ends Lat 32 51 south Long 165 23 west

Sunday the 27th

Commences with fresh gales from the S & ship heading S S W the watch employed in duty sent down the mizen Rial yard & mast took in the flying jib & mizen-top-galant-sails Middle Part ship heading S by E rain squalls Lat Past light winds set the flying jib & mizen-top-galant-sail saw a ship astern so ends this Day Lat 35 07 Long 166 05
