

Remarks on Board bound to the Coast of Chile
October 1846

Friday the 16th

Commenced with light winds from the S W steering
E S E the watch employed in various jobs of ships
Duty Middle Part light winds from W N W shifted
the studdensails from starboard to the Larboard side
steering E by S Latter Part the watch employed in
various jobs of ships duty so ends in Lat 38° 18

Saturday the 17th

Commenced with light winds from W N W steering
E by S Middle Part light winds from the
S W Latter Part light airs from S S E ship
heading E so ends this Day Lat 38° 46

Sunday the 18th

Commenced with light airs from E N E ship
heading S E Middle Part light airs & calms
Latter Part light wind from N E by N steering
E S E set the fore-top-mast-studdensail
so ends this Day Lat 39° 30
Long 122° 06

Monday the 19th

First Part light winds from N E by N set the
main-top-galant-studdensail steering E S E
Middle Part the same Latter Part five breezes from
the N N E so ends this Day Lat 41° 15
Long 118° 40

Tuesday the 20th

First Part light winds from the N N E steering
E by S Middle Part the same Latter Part
fresh gale & thick weather so ends this Day
no observation

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Wednesday the 21st

First Part fresh gale from the N N W with rain
took in the studdensails & main Royal set the
main-top-mast-studdensail again steering E
Middle Part strong gale from W N W took in the
studdensails Latter Part strong gale from the W
took in the main Royal fore & mizen top-galant-sails
double reefed the fore & mizen top-sails hoisted up
the boats set main-top-galant-studdensail for a fore
top-mast-studdensail so ends this Day Lat 43° 25
A & P Long 110° 00

Thursday the 22nd

First Part strong winds from W by S set the
lower-studdensail & main Royal steering E per
Compass Middle Part strong gale from W N W
took in the studdensails Latter Part fresh breeze
turned the reefs out of the fore-top-sail set the fore
top-galant-sail & studdensails so ends this Day
No observation

Friday the 23rd

First Part fresh gale from W S W & thick weather
steering E Middle Part set the mizen-top-galant-sail
& flying jib Latter Part set the lower-studdensail
so ends this Day Latitude 43° 58

Saturday the 24th

First Part strong breezes from the south West
took in the lower-studdensail & main-top-galant-studdensail
Middle Part set the main-top-galant-studdensail
& took it in again Latter Part strong breezes from S W
by S steering E N E so ends this Day Lat 45° 48
Long 95° 47
