

Remarks on Board Bound to the Island Mocha
June 1847

Wednesday the 9th

Begins with light winds from the Northward & rain by the full ship heading to the Eastward under easy sail Middle Part fine weather Latter Part light airs from the Westward & pleasant weather steering E S E the watch repairing a main-top-galant-sail & sails in sight so ends

Lat 37° 57'

Long 75° 05'

Thursday the 10th

Begins with light airs & from the Westward & fine weather steering E S E & changed fore-top-sail Middle Part light winds from NW to N Latter Part fresh breezes & rain squalls veered ship to the Westward so ends

Friday the 11th

Begins with strong winds from the NW ship heading NW under easy sail Middle part veered ship to the Eastward Latter Part bad weather so ends in

Lat 37° 29'

Saturday the 12th

Begins with fresh gales from the NW Middle Part light winds from the Westward Latter Part much the same so ends in

Lat 39° 29'

Sunday the 13th

Begins with light winds from the westward pleasant weather steering N E by E Middle Part veered ship to the West & West Latter Part light winds from S S W thick weather steering E so ends this Day

Remarks on Board

June 1847

Monday the 14th

Begins with light winds from the Westward steering E N E at 2 P.M. saw the Island Mocha bearing E by N Middle Part squally Latter Part fair weather steering in shore so ends this Day

Tuesday the 15th

Begins with strong winds from the Westward ship heading NW under reefed courses & lost reefed top-sails Middle Part light airs & calms Latter Part much the same one sail in sight

Lat 38° 01'

Wednesday the 16th

Begins with a calm the watch employed in repairing the fore & Mizzen top-galant-sails Middle Part strong winds from NW to N Latter Part more moderate so ends this Day

Lat 37° 51'

Thursday the 17th

Begins with light winds from NW ship heading N one brig in sight standing to the N Middle Part fresh breezes from the Westward Latter Part fresh gales from W S W steering N

Lat 36° 54'

Long 75° 55'

Friday the 18th

Begins with light winds from W S W ships came N E & changed main-top-galant-sails Middle & Latter Parts calm

Saturday the 19th

First Part calm St. Thomas Island & the main land in sight & 3 sails Middle Part Middle & Latter Parts calm the Land in sight & 4 sails
