

Remarks on Board off Waquoit August 1847

Sunday the 8th
light winds & fine weather Latter Part the
Land in sight Lat 42.29

Monday the 9th
Begins with light winds from the S
steering N.W. to Chiloe in sight -
at dark shortened sail & began heading to
the westward Middle Part light winds from the
westward Latter Part fresh gales from the same
Lat 42.16

Tuesday the 10th
Begins with fresh gales from the westward
Middle Part light winds Latter Part the same
the Land in sight Lat 42.05

Wednesday the 11th
Begins with light winds from the westward
ship heading S.W. Middle Part much
the same Latter Part strong breezes &
cloudy No observation

Thursday the 12th
Begins with fresh breezes from N.W. ship
heading N.W. Middle Part light winds
& fine weather Lat Part strong winds
from the westward thick weather No observation

Friday the 13th
Begins with strong winds from the
westward one ship in sight Middle Part
light winds Latter Part strong winds
No observation

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Saturday the 14th
Begins with fresh gales from the westward
thick weather ship sailing to the Northward
spoke ship Montano of Mantacket
Middle Part strong gales Latter Part the same
Lat 42.13

Sunday the 15th
Begins with strong gales from S.W.
ship under close reefed main top sail Middle Part
the same Latter Part more moderate spoke ship
Montano so ends this day Lat 41.36

Monday the 16th
Fresh gales from the westward Middle & Latter
Parts light winds one ship in sight Lat 41

Tuesday the 17th
Begins with light winds from the southward
Middle Part the same Latter Part fresh breezes
spoke ship Moise of Nantes France
6 months out clean so ends this day
Lat 41.36 Long 76.32

Wednesday the 18th
Begins with fresh gales & thick weather
Middle & Latter Parts much the same
No observation

Thursday the 19th
Begins with light winds & foggy Middle
Part light airs. Latter much the same ship under
a press of sail steering E.N.E.
Friday August 20th
Begins with fresh gales from the N.W. more high
to the S.W. at dark shortened sail for the night
Middle & Latter Parts strong gales. So Ends.
