

Remarks on Board Homeward Bound
September 1847

Sunday the 12th

Begins with fresh breezes from WNW steering S by E set fore-top-mast-saddling-sail & bent a new fore-top ^{galant} sail & some new running rigging &c. Middle Part strong winds from W steering S by E per compass. Latter Part light winds from the WNW steering south by E set lower saddling-sail & main-top gallant-studding sail so ends this Day
Lat 50° 11' Long 80° 20'

Monday the 13th

Begins with light winds from the NW steering S by E. Middle Part strong winds from NW by W steering S by E took in the studding-sails. Latter Part strong winds from the NW set fore-top-mast-studding-sail took in the fore-top gallant-sail Lat 53° 08' Long 80° 12'

Tuesday the 14th

The wind changed to the WSW close reefed the fore-top-sail & reefed the fore-sail & double reefed the main-top-sail & close reefed the mizen-top-sail & furled the main-sail steering S by E. Middle Part strong gales from the W turned the reef out of the fore-sail & set the main-sail & jib took in the jib again steering S by E. Latter Part strong winds from the WNW turned the reefs out of the fore-top-sail & set the fore-top gallant-sail & took it in again & took in the main-sail --- the main-top-sail single reefed & top-gallant-sail over it

Long 78° 46'

Remarks on Board off Cape Horn
September 1847

Wednesday the 15th

Begins with strong gales from WNW double reefed the fore-top-sail & took one reef in it again steering S by E. Middle Part set the fore-top gallant-sail & took it in again & took in the main-top-gallant-sail & the fore-top-sail steering S. Latter Part strong gales from W by S took the second reef in the main-top-sail steering S so ends this Day
Lat 57° 06' Long 72° 30'

Thursday the 16th

Begins with strong gales from W by S set the fore-top-sail double reefed steering S by W. Middle Part strong gales from W & W set the mizen-top-sail & jib & main-sail took them in again took in the fore-sail steering S by W. Latter Part strong gales from W & W set the fore-sail reefed steering S by W
Lat 57° 45' Long 67° 33'

Friday the 17th

Begins with strong gales from the SW & a plenty of snow steering NW by W. Middle Part set the fore-top-sail & the main-top gallant-sail. Latter Part strong winds from WNW turned the reef out of the fore-sail took in the main-top gallant-sail & close reefed the fore-top-sail & double reefed the main steering NW by E so ends this Day
Lat 55° 47' Long 75° 30'
