Begins with strong trades all hands
employed in fitting rigging & painting
steering NW by W Middle Part strong
NNE trade winds Latter Part the same
steering NW by W so ends this Day

Monday November the 15th

Begins with strong NNE trade winds
steering NW by W Middle Part strong
winds steering NW Latter Part
fresh breezes all hands employed in
fitting rigging &c steering NW

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Tuesday the 16th

Begins with moderate NNE trade winds
all hands employed in fitting rigging &c
steering NW Middle Part very light
winds Latter Part light trade winds
all hands employed in painting ship
& fitting rigging steering NW saw
gulf weed Lat 22° 01'
Long 59° 20'

Wednesday November the 17th

Begins with light NNE trade winds
all hands employed in painting ship
& fitting rigging Middle Part light winds
steering NW by W Latter Part light winds
all hands employed in painting ship &c
Lat 23° 23'
Long 61° 23'

Thursday the 18th

Begins with light NNE trade winds
all hands employed in painting &c steering
NW by N at 5 P M commenced a strong
breeze from the NNE & a heavy sea from the
NW took in the studding sails & sails
top galant sails & flying jib Middle Part
strong winds courses NW by N
Latter Part strong winds from the NNE
ship under top sails & courses steering
NW by N the watch employed in various
jobs about the ship
