

Monday, Oct. 30th, 1848.

The day commenced with a moderate breeze and fair weather, ended with frequent and heavy squalls of wind & rain.
Dist run 60 miles
Lat 8° 53' N. Long 21° 17' West

Tuesday, Oct. 31st.

The weather to day, has been "changeable,"

Lat 8° 13' N. Long 20° 52' W.

Wednesday Nov 1st

Commenced fair, latter part squally - saw Black fish to day, but did not get any.

Lat 7° 53' N. Long 21° 06' W.

Thursday Nov 2^d

First part of the day calm, and thick weather, a number of fish in sight, latter part fair, a few ptarmigan in sight.

Lat 7° 46' N. Long 19° 46' W.

Friday, Nov, 3^d

has been pleasant, and most of the time calm, the Brig is in sight, a few miles distant.

Lat 7° 16' N. Long 19° 24' W.

Saturday, Nov, 4th

Pleasant and calm, two sails in sight.

Lat 7° 03' N. Long 19° 22' W.

Sunday, Nov, 5th -

Pleasant and calm as usual, a ship & a Brig in sight, the ship has all sail set steering South.

Lat 6° 28' N. Long 19° 42' W.

Monday, Nov, 6th

This day has been pleasant, with light wind, have had a little thunder, there are three vessels in sight.

Lat 5° 53' North Long 19° 18' West

Tuesday, Nov 7th, 1848,

commenced with light wind, and variable, ship by the wind, and all sail set. at 3 P.M. exchanged signals with an English Barge, middle and latter part of the day calm, with frequent showers of rain.
Lat 5° 26' N. Long 19° 17' W.

Wednesday, Nov, 8th

this day has been pleasant, with a light wind.

Lat 5° 21' N. Long 19° 58' West

Thursday Nov 9th

first part of the day pleasant with light airs, latter part calm with squalls of rain, the man at mast head raised Black fish at 4 P.M. the boats were lowered and gave chase, but without success.

Lat 4° 51' N. Long 18° 53' West

Friday, Nov, 10th.

First part pleasant weather and calm. Middle part a moderate breeze, and variable with heavy rain, latter part calm, have seen a number of Finback whales, thus ends this day, no prospect of a breeze.

Lat 4° 46' N. Long 18° 28' West

Saturday, Nov, 11th

Commenced as above, calm with frequent rain - ends the same. saw a ship steering to the North.

Lat 4° 40' North - Long 18° 07' West

Sunday, Nov, 12th

has been calm, and rainy as usual.

Lat 4° 30' North - Long 18° 15' West

Monday, Nov, 13th

First part of the day rainy, latter part pleasant with a fresh breeze - saw a ship steering North.

Lat 4° 32' N. Long 18° 43' West

Tuesday, Nov, 14th -

Has been pleasant, with a fresh breeze, at sunset a sail in sight.

Lat 1° 57' N. Long 20° 09' West
