

Saturday Oct 27th 1860

This day Commences with a light Air from the North and fine weather steering S by E at 11 AM wind halled to the S by W at 2 o'clock wind from the S by W latter part the wind from the N and fine weather one ship in sight

Lat by Obs 31.42 Long by Chron 23.08

Sunday Oct 28th 1860

Commences with a moderate breeze from the W and fine weather at midnight wind halled to the North with squalls of rain latter part wind from the S by E and squally steering S by W with all sail set so ends

Lat by Obs 32.54 Long by Chron

Monday Oct 29th 1860

Commences with a fresh breeze from the S by E and cloudy middle part cloudy with some rain latter part fine weather steering S by W

Lat by Obs 25.22 Long by Chron 23.38

Tuesday Oct 30th 1860

Commences with a fresh breeze and fine weather wind from the S by E steering S by W at 5 PM bent and set the fore topmast Studding sail middle and latter part the same

Lat by Obs 22.39 Long by Chron 24.00

Wednesday Oct 31st 1860

Commences with a light wind from the S by E and cloudy middle part Calm with light squalls of Rain latter part light breeze from the E steering by the wind to the South so ends this day

Lat by Obs 21.06

Thursday Oct 32nd 1860

Commences with a light wind from the E with some rain steering by the wind to the South middle part fine weather steering by the wind to the S at daylight St Nicholas Baring 8 W Leagues dist Ship heading S by E with a moderate breeze from the E at noon the Land Baring S by W 5 Leagues distant

Thursday Nov 1st 1860

Commences with a light wind from the E steering by the wind to the S middle and latter part light airs and fine weather

Lat by Obs 17.03 Long by Chron 24.54

Friday Nov 2nd 1860

These 24 hours a light wind from the E and fine weather steering S by W at sundown took in studding sails and halled by the wind to the S at daylight the Island of St Nicholas Baring 9 W Leagues dist Ship heading S by E at meridian Land bore S by W 5 Leagues dist

Lat by Obs 16.52 Long by Chron 23.39

Saturday Nov 3rd 1860

Commences with moderate breeze and fine weather steering S by E at 3 PM East End of St Nicholas Baring 8 W Leagues dist the Ship bent and set the studding sails at 6 PM Land bore S by W 5 Leagues at 6 o'clock St Jago bore E 5 Leagues distant latter part Calm so ends
