Commences with very light airs and Calms at 5 P.M. the 1st end of St. Jago Boring E & Ligne at 6 took a Breeze from the E and Steered S.W. Middle and Latter part strong Breeze and fine weather so ends this Day

Monday Nov 5th 1860

Commences with a moderate breeze from the E and fine weather steering S.W. Middle and Latter part light Baffling airs steering S at 11 A.M. saw Blackfish Lowered the Boats and took five of them so ends

Lat By Obs 14.10 Long by Chro 21.20

Tuesday Nov 6th 1860

Begins with Light air from the E and fine weather the Boats down chasing Black fish at 1 P.M. took the five to the Ship and took the Boats up at 3 lowered again and took One more at 4 Came Onboard and took them on Board and striped the Bluber from them middle part a very light air Latter part a light Breeze from the E steir I saw a number Sholes of B. Fish

Wednesday Nov 7th 1860

Commences with a light air from the E and fine weather steering S at 6 P.M. commenced Boiling the Blackfish at 1 A.M. cooled down the Blackfish made 7 bls latter part light air so ends this Day

Thursday November 8th 1860

Comes with light airs and calms middle and latter part the same steering S so ends this day
Lat by Obs 8.54 Long by Chro 20.34

Friday Nov 9th 1860

These 24 hours commences with light baffling airs varying from E to S.E steering S by S latter part squally with rain steering by the wind to the S.W. so ends

Lat By Obs 6.57 Long by Chro 21.00

Saturday Nov 10th 1860

Commences with a fresh breeze from the S.E and cloudy steering by the wind to the S.W. middle part strong wind heading S.W. by S latter part the same so ends

Sunday Nov 11th 1860

Commences with a strong wind from the S.E with squalls of rain middle and latter part the same steering by the wind heading S.W. by S

Monday Nov 12th 1860

Commences with a strong wind from the S.E by S steering S.W. by S middle part the same latter part wind from the S.E heading S.W.

Tuesday Nov 13th 1860

Commences with a strong wind from the S.E and fine weather steering by the wind to the S.W. middle and latter part the same
