

Saturday Nov 24th 1860

Commences with a moderate breeze from the S E and fine weather steering S E by S
at 4 P.M. saw 2 pinbacks middle and latter part the wind from the S and good weather saw a number of pinbacks

Lat by Obs 33.09 Long by Chro 17.55

Sunday Nov 25th 1860

Begins with a strong breeze from the S and hazy weather middle part the same latter part wind from the S S W and light with a heavy swell from the S W

ships course this day S E by S
Lat by Obs 34.55 Long by Chro 15.30

Monday Nov 26th 1860

Commences with a light wind from the S W thick hazy weather steering S E by S a heavy swell from the S W many pinbacks in sight middle and latter part the same

Lat by Obs 35.34

Tuesday Nov 27th 1860

Commences with a strong breeze from the S S E with thick hazy weather steering S E by S
at 7 P.M. took in sail for the night and hauled on the wind to the E at 4 A.M. made all sail and steered S E by E weather hazy

Lat by Obs 36.41 Long by Chro 13.00

Wednesday Nov 28th 1860

Begins with a strong wind from the S S E and good weather steering S E by S at 2 P.M. made hazy S E by E 5 leagues hauled on the wind to the E at 7 P.M. and hauled S W 5 leagues middle and latter part the same

Lat by Obs 36.41 Long by Chro 11.00

Thursday Nov 29th 1860

Commences with a strong breeze from the S S E and fine weather steering by the wind to the E all hands employed in breaking out in the fore, main, middle and latter part wind from the S steering E latter part thick hazy weather saw several Humpbacks

Lat by Obs 35.59 Long by Chro 5.40 W

Friday Nov 30th 1860

Commences with a strong wind from the S with wet hazy weather at 4 P.M. saw a whaler to the S E steering the same way the we were at 7 she was out of sight a stern at 9 P.M. saw a ship ahead with studding sails staysails Royals and all the light sails she could carry the Good Ship Fire Perry, with topsail and sails set passed her as though she was losing still. Steering S E at 9 P.M. steering S E middle part fresh gales from the S and thick weather latter part strong gales steering S E

Lat by Obs 35.45 Long by Chro 10.40 W

Saturday December 1st 1860

Commences with strong gales from the S S W with thick wet weather at 4 P.M. double reefed the top sails took in the main sail middle part the wind hauled to the S W at 5 A.M. wind hauled to the South ships course S E latter part more moderate set the top sails the main sail saw Humpbacks and Pinbacks
