

Thursday Jan 3rd 1861

Commences with a moderate breeze from W³N³W and fine weather steering S³E with all sail set One Bark in sight to the S³W steering to the S³E middle part strong breeze double reefed the fore and mizen top sail at daylight more moderate and fine weather saw a number of fin Backs
Lat by Obs 45.20 Long by Chro 68.10

Friday Jan 4th 1861

Comes with a strong wind from the S³W and fine weather steering S³E under short sail at 4 set all sail middle and latter part light wind and foggy steering S³E with all sail set saw Calf penguins and seals

Saturday Jan 5th 1861

Comes with a light wind from the S³W and foggy steering S³E with all sail set middle part the same latter part strong winds and clear weather steering S³E with studding sails set
Lat by Obs 45.38 Long by Chro 69.00

Sunday Jan 6th 1861

Commences with a strong wind from the S³W and good weather steering S³E at 6 PM wind from the S³W and cloudy saw a number of Killers. at 4 Bent a new Fore Sail middle part wind from the W latter part light air and fine weather wind from the S³W heading S³E Lat by Obs 46.24 Long by Chro 61.55

Monday Jan 7th 1861

Begins with light air and calm heading to the Eastward at 5 PM light air from the S³E heading to the S³W middle part moderate breeze from the S³E and good weather Lat part strong breeze steering by the wind to the S³E saw several fin Backs
Lat by Obs 47.22 Long by Chro 64.00

Tuesday Jan 8th 1861

Commences with a strong breeze from the S³E and fine weather steering by the wind heading from S³E by S to S³E by E middle part the same latter part moderate breeze and fine weather at 4 AM steered S³E
Lat by Obs 48.02 Long by Chro 68.40

Wednesday Jan 9th 1861

Commences with a moderate breeze from the S³E and fine weather steering S³E by W at 11 O'clock P.M. saw Blighs Capt & 5 leagues at 2 halted on the wind to the S³E by E at 4 P.M. bent a new Fore Main Topsail middle part fresh breeze from the S³E heading S³E at 12 tack to the S³W at 4 PM tacked to the S³E two ships in sight latter part foggy and calm

Thursday Jan 10th 1861

Begins with light wind from the S³E and thick fog steering by the wind to the S³E at 3 PM Calm at 8 PM light wind and rainy at midnight wind hells to the W and then a gale took in all sail except close reefed Main Topsail and staysails and hove the ship too heading S³W at 8 AM cept off E and set Fore Sail and double reefed topsails at 10 set whole main Topsail and main top Gallant Sail saw one rite whale
Lat by Obs 46.55 Long by Chro 61.35

Friday Jan 11th 1861

Begins with strong gales from the W steering E heavy sea at 2 PM turned up the Boat middle part more moderate set whole Fore Topsail and main top Gallant Sail at 8 PM set all sail strong wind from the S³W steering S³E
Lat by Obs 45.09 Long by Chro 76.10
