

Friday Jan 12th 1861

Begins with fresh gales from the S with thick rainy weather steering ESE at 4 took in top gal last & sails at 6 double reefed at 7 close reefed. Blowing hard from the S steering SE by E middle part more moderate at 2 AM set whole fore and main topsails and main top gallant sail wind WSE at 7 set all sail moderate breeze at 10 set the studding sails
Lat By Obs 44.53 Long By Chro 80.45

Sunday Jan 13th 1861

Comes with a moderate breeze from W and good weather steering SE by E at 3 PM wind halled to the SW shifted the studding sails and steered ESE at 4. Went a few fms middle part fresh gales thick hazy weather latter part strong gales steering ESE with all sail set

Monday Jan 14th 1861

Commences with strong gales from the SSW with cloudy weather steering ESE with all sail set at 8 PM took in top gallant sails at 1 AM wind halled suddenly to the WSE latter part more moderate steering SE by E. One ship in sight to the W
Lat by Obs 44.22 Long By Obs 91.20

Tuesday Jan 15th 1861

Commences with a fresh breeze from the WSE and good weather steering SE by E. One ship in sight astern. Middle part moderate lat part the same wind WSE steering ESE two sail in sight saw one ship part
Lat By Obs 44.30 Long By Chro 95.20

Wednesday Jan 16th 1861

Commences with fresh breeze from WSE and good weather steering ESE with all sail set two sail in sight middle part strong breeze latter part strong blinding and cloudy at 10 AM took in top gallant sails
Lat By Obs 44.42 Long By Chro 100.25

Thursday Jan 17th 1861

Commences with moderate gales from the WSE and cloudy steering ESE at 3 PM strong gales double reefed the fore and mizzen topsails at 7 double reefed the main top sail wind SSW middle and latter part strong gales with fog and rain at 4 set whole main topsail and main top gallant sail at 9 AM saw a ship to the SW
Lat by Obs 44.42 Long By Chro 105.50

Friday Jan 18th 1861

Begins with strong wind from the WSE and thick rainy weather steering ESE very heavy sea from the SSW middle and latter part more moderate at 3 AM made all sail latter part good weather so ended
Lat By Obs 44.33 Long By Chro 110.18

Saturday Jan 19th 1861

Comes with strong gales from WSE and good weather steering ESE at 3 PM double reefed the fore and mizzen topsails and steered E by S at 6 squally middle part the same latter part more moderate at 5 PM set the studding sails steering ESE weather good
Lat By Obs 44.28 Long By Chro 114.52 Long By Luner 115.12

Sunday Jan 20th 1861

Commences with a fresh wind from the WSE and good weather steering E by S at 4 wind halled to the WSE middle part strong winds and squally lat part moderate breeze and fine weather wind from SW to West
Lat By Obs 44.44 Long By Chro 118.10

Monday Jan 21st 1861

Commences with light winds from the WSE and good weather steering E by S at 5 PM light squalls of rain wind SSW by W middle part squally with rain at 1 AM the wind halled to the WSE latter part strong winds with good weather
Lat By Obs 44.51 Long By Chro 123.02
