

Saturday February 2^d 1861

Commences with a strong breeze from the SSE and good weather steering by the wind to the SSW at 6 P.M. Cloudy middle part squally with rain at 2 P.M. wind hauled to the SSE & tacked to the SSE latter part strong winds with rain steering by the wind to the SSE by E at 9 P.M. Double reefed the fore and mizen topsails, weather thick and rain.
Lat By Obs 39° 25' Long By AC 161° 50'

Sunday Feb 3^d 1861

Commences with a strong breeze from the SSE with squally weather steering by the wind to the SSE by E middle part squally with rain latter part fresh breeze from the S and good weather steering by the wind to the Eastward.
Lat By Obs 38° 33' Long By Chro 164° 18'

Monday Feb 4th 1861

Comes with a fresh breeze from the S and fine weather steering by the wind to the Eastward middle part light breeze at 10 tacked ship to the westward latter part fresh breeze from the SE & heading by the wind to the SSW by W.
Lat By Obs 38° 18' Long By Chro 164° 58'

Tuesday Feb 5th 1861

Comes with a fresh breeze from the S and good weather steering by the wind to the SSW at 7 P.M. tacked ship to the Eastward middle part fresh breeze and fine weather heading to the E at 2 P.M. tacked ship to the SSW by W latter part strong winds and good weather wind from the S heading by the wind the SSW so ended.

Lat By Obs 37° 28' Long By Chro 164° 54'

Wednesday Feb 6th 1861

Commences with a strong breeze from the S and fine weather steering by the wind to the SSW at 10 P.M. tacked ship to the Eastward One ship in sight to the North middle part the same Lat part moderate breeze and fine weather steering by the wind to the Eastward.
Lat By Obs 37° 16' Long By Chro 166° 21'

Thursday Feb 7th 1861

Commences with a moderate breeze from the S and fine weather at 10 P.M. tacked to the Eastward at 4 tacked to the westward at 7 some what squally middle part fresh breeze and fine weather at 2 P.M. tacked to the Eastward at 6 tacked to the SSW latter part fine weather.
Lat By Obs 36° 33' Long By Chro 165° 46'

Friday Feb 8th 1861

Comes with light wind from the S and fine weather steering by the wind to the SSW middle and latter part the same sailing in sight this day.
Lat By Obs 34° 59' Long By Chro 163° 21'

Saturday Feb 9th 1861

Begins with light wind from the S and fine weather steering by the wind to the SSW at 4 heading SSW several fin backs in sight middle and latter part strong winds and cloudy some rain at 7 P.M. wind hauled to the SSE heading by the wind from SSW to SSW.
Lat By Obs 33° 14' Long By Chro 161° 30'

Sunday Feb 10th 1861

Begins with a strong wind from the SSE and cloudy steering by the wind to the Eastward at 5 P.M. took in main topgallant sail middle part the same latter part strong winds and cloudy some rain heading to the eastward with main top gallant sail set.
Lat By Obs 33° 51' Long By Chro 164° 20'
