

Thursday March 14th 1861

Commences with strong Gale from the ESE and Good weather heading to the SE under double reefed Main topsail and foresail at 3 PM took in the Fore sail and close reefed the Topsail at 7 Squally more ships to the S a heavy Sea running middle part the same latter part more moderate at 5 AM set double reefed Top sails and wore ship to the SESE at 5 this morning Gundy Island S 72° 24 miles distant

Friday March 15th 1861

Comes with fresh gales from the E and good weather heading by the wind to the SESE under double reefed Topsails at sundown took in Fore and Mizzen top Sails and wore ship to the SSE middle part more moderate at 1 AM set double reefed Fore and Mizzen Topsails latter part strong winds at 6 AM set Jib and mainsail and whole main Topsail at Meridian Gundy Island 72° 30 miles

Saturday March 16th 1861

Comes with a strong wind from the E and Cloudy steering by the wind to the SSE at 2 PM wore ship to the SESE at 4 double reefed the main Topsail at 6 took in the mainsail middle and latter part fresh Gale and Cloudy at 1 AM wore ship to the S at 6 AM wore ship to the S

Sunday March 17th 1861

Begins with fresh Gale from the ESE and Cloudy steering by the wind to the S under double reefed Top sails at 4 AM wore ship to the SE middle part strong Gale at 1 AM took in the fore and mizen topsails at 5 AM more moderate set double reefed Topsails latter part fresh Breeze from the SE and Cloudy steering by the wind ESE with main top Gallant set

Monday March 18th 1861

Commences with fresh breeze and Cloudy wind from the SE steering by the wind to the E at 4 PM raining a heavy swell from the E at 6 PM took in main Top gallant tail still raining at 7 hard squalls with rain double reefed the Topsails middle part squally at 8 AM set whole Top sails and main Top Gallant tails strong wind from the SESE heading to the SE. SESE this day

Tuesday March 19th 1861

This day comes with strong wind from the SE and squalls of rain at 1 double reefed the Fore and Mizzen Topsails steering by the wind to the Eastward middle and latter part more moderate at 5 AM set maintop Gallant Sail at 6 tacked ship to the Westward wind from the SE and Cloudy some rain

Lat by Obs 28.04 Long by Chro 173.08 W

Wednesday March 20th 1861

Commences with fresh breeze from the SE and Cloudy steering by the wind to the Westward at 4 tacked to the ESE middle part moderate breeze latter part the same with fine weather nothing in sight this day

Lat By Obs 27.46 Long By Chro 171.20

Thursday March 21st 1861

Commences with a light breeze from the SESE and fine weather steering by the wind to the SE one ship in sight to the SE heading the same middle and latter part light wind from the SE and fine weather at 6 AM tacked to the westward nothing in sight

Lat By Obs 27.30 Long By Chro 171.42

Friday March 22nd 1861

Begins with light winds from the SE and fine weather steering by the wind to the westward at 7 PM wind from the SESE tacked ship to the SE latter part the same employed in fitting rigging
