

Sunday March 31st 1861
Commences with Light breeze from the N.W. and fine
steering by the wind to the S. middle part the same
at 7 P.M. wore ship to the S.W. at 12 tacked to the S. Latter
part strong winds from the S.W. steering by the wind to
the S.W. nothing in sight this day
Lat by Obs 21° 10' Long by Chro 168° 21'

Monday April 1st 1861
Commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. and
fine weather steering by the wind to the S.W. at 7 P.M.
light air wore ship to the S.W. at midnight tacked
to the S.W. wind from the W. Latter part light
air from the S.W. heading by the wind to the S.W.
Lat by Obs 19° 04' Long by Chro 167° 32'

Tuesday April 2nd 1861
Comes with light air from the W. steering by
the wind to the S. at 3 P.M. wind halled to the
S. at 4 past 5 fresh breeze and squally steered down
in squaring the yards two men at the mizzen
top sail braces let the braces go and went to
fitting. I thought it my duty to spanish them
I had the one by the same of
in the rigging and struck him 5 times with two
parts of 15 thread the other by the
same of I gave 6 times with out
middle part squally with rain at daylight min
S.E. steering S.W. with pleasant weather
Lat by Obs 17° 50' Long by Chro 167° 50'

Wednesday April 3rd 1861
Commences with S.E. wind and fine weather steering
S.W. at 3 P.M. had a squall of rain at 4 fine weather
middle and latter part the same steering S.W.
Employed setting up Shooks and washing ship
Lat by Obs 16° 42' Long by Chro 169° 02'

Thursday April 4th 1861
Commences with light winds from the S. and fine weather
steering S.W. at 6 P.M. Light baffling wind from S.E.
to E. with showers of rain middle part light air from
the S.E. latter part calm employed setting up Shooks
and cleaning the Iron work about the ship
Lat by Obs 16° 06' Long by Chro 169° 37'

Friday April 5th 1861
Commences with light air and calm heading S.W.
Employed cleaning the Iron work at 3 P.M. saw
a Boon Shark middle part light air from the S. latter
part from the W. with fine weather
Lat by Obs 15° 39' Long by Chro 170° 02'

Saturday April 6th 1861
Commences with a light air from the W. and fine weather
steering S.W. at 4 P.M. shifted the
Fore Sail and Fore Topsails middle part calm latter
part light air from the Westward steering by the wind
to the S. at 6 P.M. saw Boutouilla bearing S by W
at Meridian Land S 35 miles distant
Lat by Obs 15° 05'

Sunday April 7th 1861
Comes with light winds from the W. and fine weather
at 4 P.M. thick cloudy weather and calm some
rain at 6 thunder and lightning took in Topsails
sails halled up the courses at 10 P.M. Light wind from
the E.S.E. heading to the S. at midnight wore ship to
the S.E. at 3 A.M. wore ship to the S. at daylight
Boutouilla S 10 leagues distant latter part moderate
breeze from the E. and fine weather steering S.W.
at 10 saw Oppoulou to the S.W. at 11 saw
Boutouilla S.E. 11 miles distant
Lat by Obs 14° 26' Long by Chro 170° 50'
