

Monday April 8th 1861

Commence with moderate breeze from the E and good weather steering S S W at 4 squally with rain at 6 took in Bopgallant Sails and mainsail. Pontouila S E by E 10 miles distant Opoulou W 15 miles distant at 7 P M heavy squalls of wind and rain double reefed the topsails heaving by the wind to the S middle part light airs latter part squally with calms at daylight Opoulou S W 20 miles Pontouila S E at Meridian Opoulou S W

Tuesday April 9th 1861

Comes with squalls of wind and rain from the S W at 6 P M moderate airs from the S E steering by the wind to the S at 6 P M Opoulou S W 15 miles distant Uvav W by S middle part calm latter part light winds from the S W and fine weather steering in for the land at noon Opoulou S W 20 miles

Wednesday April 10th 1861

Commences with light winds from the S W and fine weather steering in for the harbor of Apia at 6 took a pilot and wore ship and stood off shore. Middle and latter part light airs at 12 wore ship and stood in for the harbor of Apia at Meridian the harbor bore S. 8 miles distant

Thursday April 11th 1861

Comes with light airs from the E and fine weather steering in for the harbor at 3 P M come to anchor in 5 fathoms water furled the sails and sent a raft ashore for water. we lay here until the 23 with light airs and calms with rain took and board 25 bbls water 8 tons yams a plenty of Oranges Bernannes 15 pigs &c

Tuesday April 23rd 1861

Comes with calms middle part the same at 8 AM fresh wind from the E took the anchor and stood to sea at 9 discharged the Pilot and stood to the S S W the anchors at 12 the Harbor S 16 miles Lat By Obs 13.41 Long by Lunar 171.21

Wednesday April 24th 1861

Comes with strong trades from the E and fine weather at 7 tacked ship to the South wind from E S E at 9 AM tacked ship to the S E at daylight the east end Upolou bearing S S W 25 miles distant at Meridian W 15 miles distant Lat By Obs 14.47 Long by Chron 170.59

Thursday April 25th 1861

Commences with strong trades from the E S E and fine weather steering by the wind to the S at 4 P M tacked ship to the S E the lee end of Pontouila bearing S E 10 leagues distant at 10 tacked to the South at 3 P M tacked to the S at daylight Land bearing S 15 miles at 7 tacked ship to the S at Meridian the E End of Pontouila S 10 leagues distant Lat by Obs 14.25 Long by Chron 170.21

Friday April 26th 1861

Comes with strong trades from the E S E and good weather at 1 P M tacked ship to the S at sundown the E end of Pontouila S S W 15 miles distant middle and latter part strong wind steering by the wind to the S S E Lat By Obs 12.45 Long by Chron 169.41 W

Saturday April 27th 1861

Commences with a strong wind from the E and squally steering by the wind to the S S E middle and latter part fresh wind and fine weather steering by the wind to the S Lat by Obs 11.45 Long by Chron 16.50
