

Saturday May 18th 1861

Commences with moderate breeze and fine weather steering S W at 6 P M took in sail and halled on the wind to the S middle and latter part fresh breeze and fine weather at midnight wore ship to the S E at daylight set the main topgallant sail and steered S

Lat by Obs 1.43 S Long by Chro 170.41 W

Sunday May 19th 1861

Commences with strong breeze from the E and fine weather steering S by W at 6 P M took in sail for the night and haled to the heading S S E middle and latter part strong breeze and fine weather at midnight wore ship to the S at 6 A M wore ship and set all sail and steered S by W saw nothing this day

Lat by Obs 1.47 S Long by Chro 169.42 W

Monday May 20th 1861

First part of these 24 hours a strong breeze from the E and fine weather at past meridian wore ship and steered S W at 6 P M took in sail for the night and halled on the wind to the S E middle and latter part strong wind from the E and fine weather at midnight wore ship to the S at daylight wore ship and made all sail and steered S by W employed in turning up the fore rigger

Lat by Obs 2.22 S Long by Chro 170.20 W

Tuesday May 21st 1861

Commences with strong breeze from the E and fine weather steering S W at 6 P M took in sail and halled on the wind to the S E middle and latter part strong wind and fine weather at 6 A M wore ship to the S at 10 set all sail steering by the wind to the S S E employed in turning up the rigger

Lat by Obs 1.08 S Long by Chro 170.35 W

Wednesday May 22nd 1861

Comes with strong wind from the S E and squally steering by the wind to the S at 6 P M took in topgallant sail and mainsail and wore ship to the S E at 6 P M saw whales to the E goin quick to the E saw them two rising and saw no more of them working ship to the Eastward after the whales fresh breeze and fine weather

Lat by Obs 1.05 S Long by Chro 170.17 W

Thursday May 23rd 1861

This day comes with a fresh breeze from the E and fine weather working ship to the windward after the whales that went out of sight to the E at 6 P M took ship to the S middle and latter part the wind and weather same as the first at 1 A M tacked ship to the S at 8 A M steered to the S by W employed in rattling down the fore rigger saw nothing this day

Lat by Obs 1.45 S Long by Chro 170.23 W

Friday May 24th 1861

Commences with a strong wind from the E and fine weather steering E by S at 6 P M took in top Gallantsails and mainsail and wore ship heading S S E middle and latter part moderate breeze and fine weather at midnight wore ship to the south at 6 A M set all sail and steered S by W employed in turning up the main rigger saw nothing this day

Lat by Obs 2.28 S Long by Chro 170.42 W

Saturday May 25th 1861

Commences with a moderate breeze from the E and fine weather steering S E at 6 P M took in sail and wore ship to the S S E middle and latter part strong wind and fine weather at 6 A M steered S by W with topsails set saw nothing this day

Lat by Obs 1.42 S Long by Chro 171.05 W
