

Monday June 3rd 1861

Commences with a moderate breeze from the E and fine weather steering S by W with all sail set at 4 PM halled on the wind to the S by E at 6 took in topgallant sails middle part fresh breeze latter part strong breeze and fine weather at 12 midnight wore ship to the S at daylight made all sail and steered by the wind heading S by E saw nothing this day

Tuesday June 4th 1861

Commences with a strong wind from the E and fine weather steering by the wind to the S by E at 4 AM wore ship to the S at 6 PM took in sail for the night middle and latter part strong wind and fine weather at 12 midnight wore ship to S at 5 AM wore ship to the S at 6 AM set all sail and steered S at 10 steered S by W saw a break and saw nothing more of it

Wednesday June 5th 1861

Commences with a strong breeze from the E and fine weather steering S by W at 3 PM took in topgallant sails at 6 PM double reefed topsails and wore ship heading S by E middle part strong latter part the same at midnight wore ship to the S at 6 AM set the jib and mainsail and steered S

Thursday June 6th 1861

Comes with strong winds from the E by S and fine weather steering S by W with double reefed topsails at 6 PM took in jib and spanker and wore ship to the S by E middle and latter part strong breeze and fine weather at midnight wore ship to S at daylight set jib and mainsail and steered S by W at 11 AM S by W

Lat By Obs 60. 05 S Long By Chro 173. 04 W

Friday June 7th 1861

Commences with a strong breeze from the E and fine weather steering S by W at 3 PM set main topgallant sail at 4 set all sail at 6 took in topgallant sails and halled on the wind to the S by E middle and latter part strong wind and fine weather at midnight wore ship to the S at 6 AM wore ship to the south and set the jib and mainsail and steered S

Lat By Obs 61. 17 S Long By Chro 173. 30 W

Saturday June 8th 1861

Comes with a fresh breeze from the E by S and fine weather steering S by W at 1 PM set all sail at 6 PM took in sail to the three topsails and halled on the wind to the S saw Blackfish and Porpoise middle and latter part fine weather at midnight wore ship to the S at 6 AM set all sail and steered S by W so ended

Lat By Obs 2. 53 S Long By Chro 174. 14 W

Sunday June 9th 1861

Commences with a strong breeze from the E and fine weather steering S by W at 6 PM double reefed the top sails and halled on the wind to the S by E Blackfish in sight middle and latter part fresh breeze and fine weather at midnight wore ship to the S at daylight set all sail and steered S by W nothing in sight

Lat by Obs 1. 51 S Long by Chro 174. 24 W

Monday June 10th 1861

Commences with a fresh breeze from the E and fine weather steering S by W at 6 took in sail for the night and halled on the wind to the S by E at daylight set all sail and steered S by W employed in repairing main top sail

Lat by Obs 60. 11 S Long by Chro 174. 34 W
