

Tuesday June 14th 1861

This day comes with a light breeze from the E and fine weather steering S W at 3 P M saw a finback at 6 P M took in top gallant sails and courses and steered W middle and latter part wind the same at midnight halled on the wind to the S at 9 Am wore ship to the S at daylight set all sail and steered S by E

Lat By Obs 11 14 S Long By Chro 175.54 W

Wednesday June 13th 1861

Commences with a light breeze from the E and fine weather steering S W at 3 P M saw Baker's Island at 6 a boat came along side from the shore took in top gallant sails and halled on the wind to the S at 1 P M wore ship to the S at daylight Baker's Island S W 10 miles at 8 Am saw Breakers saw nothing more

Thursday June 13th 1861

Comes with light airs and calms steering in for the land at 3 P M land S S E 8 miles dist lowered a boat and went on shore and left letter to be sent home and got some spapers 45 days from New York at 6 went on board and stood to the S W middle part very light airs latter part the same at 6 set all sail and steered S W saw nothing so ends

Friday June 14th 1861

Comes with a light breeze from the S E and fine weather steering S W at 3 saw Blackfish at 4 landed and chased until night got one at 6 took in sail and halled on the wind to the South at daylight set all sail and steered S W middle and latter part the wind and weather same as the first so ends this day

Saturday June 15th 1861

Comes with moderate breeze from the S E and fine weather steering S W by W at 6 P M took in top gallant sails and courses middle and latter part strong winds and fine weather at 6 Am steered S W with main top gallant sail set at 11 Am saw a Breach to the S S W steered for it saw nothing more so ends this day

Sunday June 16th 1861

Commences with a strong breeze from the E and fine weather steering S W at 6 took in the courses and main top Gallant sail middle and latter part strong winds and fine weather at 6 Am set all sail and steered S W at meridian steered S W

Lat By Obs 00.50 S Long By Chro 178.24 E

Monday June 17th 1861

Commences with a strong breeze from the E and fine weather steering S W at 6 P M took in sail to the three top sails and halled on the wind to the S S E middle part squally with rain latter part strong breeze and fine weather at daylight set all sail to the S at 9 steered S W saw large numbers of Blackfish

Lat by Obs 1.13 S Long By Chro 177.30

Tuesday June 18th 1861

Comes with a strong breeze from the E and fine weather steering S W at 6 P M took in top gallant sails fit and main sail and halled on the wind to the S E middle and latter part strong breeze and fine weather at daylight set all sail and steered to the South at 8 Am saw Hope Island bearing S E at 10 Am halled aback under the lee of it canoes came along side from the shore with coconuts to trade at 11 stood to the S at meridian land bore S E 10 miles
