

Thursday June 19th 1861
 These 24 hours strong winds from the E and fine weather
 first part steering by the wind to the S E Hope Island
 in sight to the N E at 6 P M took in sail for the night
 at 11 P M wore ship to the S E at 6 A M set all sail
 nothing more remarkable saw Blackfish
 Lat by Obs 3.089 Long by Chro 177.22 E

Thursday June 20th 1861
 Commences with a strong breeze from the E and fine
 weather steering by the wind to the S E at 3 P M Hope
 Island bearing S W 15 miles distant at 6 P M took in
 sail for the night Land bearing W S W middle and
 latter part moderate breeze at 6 A M set all sail and
 steered by the wind to the S E at meridian steered W
 Lat by Obs 1.219 Long by Chro 177.42 W

Friday June 21st 1861
 Commences with moderate breeze from the E and fine
 weather steering W at 6 P M took in sail and halled
 on the wind to the S at midnight wore ship to
 the N at 6 A M made all sail and steered W at
 meridian saw Byrons Island S W 15 miles dist
 Lat by Obs 1.11 E Long by Chro 177.12 W

Saturday June 22^d 1861
 Comes with moderate breeze from the S E and fine
 weather steering S W at 4 P M canoes came off
 from the Island halled aback and traided with
 the Natives at 6 took in sail and stood to the S E
 middle and latter part fresh breeze and fine weather
 at 1 A M wore ship to the N at 6 A M set all sail
 and steered S S W Byrons Island W 15 miles run round
 the Island to the S and steered S W at 11 A M no
 land in sight so end

Lat by Obs 1.00 Long by Chro 176.20 E

Sunday June 23^d 1861
 Comes with strong breeze from the E and fine weather
 steering S W by W at 1 P M saw Peroat Island at 4 Land S
 5 miles at 5 canoes came alongside at 5 1/2 stood to the
 N at 6 shortened sail for the night middle and
 latter part strong winds and fine weather at 1 A M
 wore ship to the S at daylight set all sail at 7
 Peroat Island S by W 15 miles distant at meridian S W
 10 miles nothing more remarkable
 Lat by Obs 1.289 Long by Chro 176.31 E

Monday June 24th 1861
 Commences with strong winds from the E and fine
 weather steering by the wind to the S E at 6 P M
 took ship to the S E at 11 P M tacked to the S E
 middle and latter part fresh breeze and fine weather
 at 6 A M set all sail by the wind to the S and Eastward
 at 7 saw Hope Island S E 15 miles distant
 Lat by Obs 2.49 S Long by Chro 176.47 E

Tuesday June 25th 1861
 Comes with fresh breeze from the E and fine weather
 steering S W at 2 P M steered S W at 5 saw Chase
 or Raches Island S W by S 15 miles at sundown
 took in sail for the night and halled the wind to
 the S at 6 A M wore ship to the N at 6 set all sail and
 steered S W
 Lat by Obs 2.38 S Long by Chro 175.42 E

Wednesday June 26th 1861
 Comes with strong breeze from the E and fine weather
 steering S W at 2 halled on the wind to the S at 4
 see Frances Island bearing S S E 20 miles dist at 6
 shortened sail and wore ship to the S E the land
 S S E 6 miles middle and latter part moderate breeze
 and fine weather at midnight wore ship to the N at daylight
 the land S 8 miles distant set all sail and steered to the
 N W at meridian Drummonds Island S W 10 miles
 Lat by Obs 1.369 Long by Chro 175.27 E
