

Friday August 9th 1861

Comes with fresh gales from the E and good weather steering by the wind to the westward at sunset took in sail middle and latter part fresh gales and squally with rain at daylight set double reefed topsails and wore ship to the SE wind from the W
No Obs this day

Saturday August 10th 1861

Comes with moderate wind and rainy wind passing from W to E and the wind with the Larboard tack On Board at dark took in sail for the night middle part strong wind and rainy latter part wind from the E steering by the wind to the SE at 10 AM wind halled to the SE
One ship in sight to the SE at meridian wore ship to the SE wind from the E ship under double reefes

Lat by Obs 25.22 N Long by Chron 174.33 W

Sunday August 11th 1861

Commences with strong winds from the SE and good weather steering by the wind to the W with double reefed topsails set at sunset took in fore and mizen topsail heading by the wind to the SE one ship in sight under short sail finished repairing the Boat Outside and painted it middle and latter part strong wind from the E and good weather at 6 AM set double reefed topsails and mainsail wore ship to the ESE and saw a number of Pinbacks

Monday August 12th 1861

Commences with strong wind and good weather steering SE wind from the ESE at sunset fresh gales took in sail and halled on the wind to the SE middle part moderate gales latter part strong double reefed topsails breeze at daylight wore ship to the SE at 10 AM saw 3 sperm One mile to the windward Lowered three Boats saw no more of the whales called the Boats On Board

Tuesday August 13th 1861

Comes with strong winds from the ESE and clear weather steering by the wind to the SE and off SE W to try to find the whales that we saw this forenoon but saw nothing at sundown wore ship to the E and took in fore and mizen topsails middle and latter part strong winds and good weather at daylight set double reefed topsails and to E at 8 wore ship to the SE at 11 wore ship to the E and Eastward saw nothing

Lat by Obs 25.04 N Long by Chron 173.46 W

Wednesday August 14th 1861

Comes with strong breeze from the E and fine weather steering by the wind to the Southeastward at sunset took in fore and mizen topsails middle and latter part strong winds from the E and good weather at daylight set double reefed topsails and steered SE W at 10 AM halled on the wind to the SE saw nothing this day

Lat by Obs 25.32 N Long by Chron 173.19 W

Thursday August 15th 1861

Comes with fresh gales from the ESE and fine weather steering by the wind to the SE at sundown took in topsails and wore ship to the SE middle part the same latter strong wind from the SESE and good weather at daylight set double reefed topsails and steered by the wind to the E

Lat by Obs 25.47 N Long by Chron 172.57 W

Friday August 16th 1861

Commences with strong double reefed Top Sail breeze and cloudy steering by the wind to the E wind SESE middle part strong wind latter part fresh gales from the SESE at daylight set double reefed topsails and steered by the wind to the SE saw nothing this day

Lat by Obs 26.01 N Long by Chron 172.55 W
