

Friday September 6th 1861

Comes with light air from the S and good weather steering
S employed in repairing and bending sails at dark Cloudy
with drizzling rain middle part fresh breeze latter part strong
wind and rainy wind from the S W steering S W by S
No Obs

Saturday September 7th 1861

Comes with moderate Gale from the S W with rain at 3
P M double reefed the top Sails at 4 took in mainsail
blowing a fresh Gale at 6 took in all sail except storm
sails and heeled to the wind to the S E middle part fresh gale
wind backing gradually to the S at daylight more moderate
set double reefed top Sails at 10 A M took them in again at
meridian strong Gale from the S heading to the Eastward
Lat by Obs 32.48 Long by Chro 162.53 W

Sunday September 8th 1861

Commences with strong gales from the S with heavy squalls
at 1 P M wore ship to the Westward middle part more moderate
wind from the S E heading S W at midnight set the fore sail
at 3 A M set the top Sails double reefed latter light air and
good weather heavy swell from the S at 8 set all sail steering
by the Wind to the S W
Lat by Obs 32.29 Long by Chro 163.01 W

Monday September 9th 1861

Commences with light air from the S E and good weather
heading S W at 3 P M wore ship to the S E wind from the S E
with a heavy swell from the S middle and latter part
light air and varying from S to W S W steering by the Wind
with the Starboard back on Board heading from S E to S W
Lat by Obs 32.45 Long by Chro 162.45 W

Tuesday September 10th 1861

Comes with a light breeze from W and good weather steering
by the Wind to the S S W middle and latter part light
wind and fine weather heading from S to S W
Lat by Obs 33. Long by Chro 163.49 W

Wednesday September 11th 1861

Commences with light air and fine weather wind varying from
W to S W steering by the wind to the S employed repairing
the Larboard Boat middle part light air and calm latter part
moderate breeze from the S E and fine weather steering S W
Lat by Obs 34.00 Long by Chro 164.51 W

Thursday September 12th 1861

Commences with fresh breeze from the S E and fine weather
steering S W middle part strong wind from the E and good
weather steering S W with all sail set latter part fresh Gale
at 11 A M double reefed the top Sails steering S W
Lat by Obs 35.20 Long by Chro 167.55 W

Friday September 13th 1861

Comes with fresh Gale from the E with squalls of rain at 3 P M
took in all sail except storm Sails and heeled on the wind
to the S middle and latter part fresh gale from the E S E and
rainy at 6 A M wore ship to the S E
No Obs this day

Saturday September 14th 1861

Commences with fresh Gale with rain laying under storm
sails to the S E at 5 P M wore ship to the S wind from
the E S E with a bad sea middle part more moderate with
rain latter part Buggy at daylight wore ship to the E S E
and set double reefed top Sails Jib and mainsail
Lat by Obs 35.12 Long by Chro 168.07 W

Sunday September 15th 1861

Commences with fresh wind from the S E with fog steering
by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P M took in sail for the
night middle part light wind from the S and foggy latter
part wind from the S W some fog at daylight set all
sail and steered S E saw nothing this day

Lat by Obs 35.21 Long by Chro 169.22
