

Monday September 16th 1861

Comes with moderate breeze from the S W and good weather steering E by N at 6 PM took in sail and haled to the wind to the N W S W middle part wind haled to the E W at 6 AM set all sail and steered N E with a fresh breeze and fine weather at meridian steered S E

Lat By Obs 34.39 Long By Chro 168.51 W

Tuesday September 17th 1861

Commences with a fresh breeze from the W and fine weather steering S E at 6 PM took in sail and haled on the wind to the S E W middle and latter part wind and weather the same at 6 AM set all sail and steered N E at meridian steered S E saw nothing this day except birds a plenty of them

Wednesday September 18th 1861

Comes with a fresh breeze from the W and fine weather steering S E at 6 PM took in sail for the night middle part light breeze from the W and good weather steering S E latter part light baffling air from W to N steering N E saw several Grampuses

Thursday September 19th 1861

Comes with a light baffling air from the Westward with fine weather steering N E middle and latter part wind light and baffling steering to the Eastward

Lat By Obs 35.45 Long By Chro 162.57 W

Friday September 20th 1861

First part of the 24 hours light air from the S and cloudy middle and latter part squally with rain latter part strong breeze from the S E steering by the wind to the Eastward at 11 AM took in topgallant Sails

Lat By Obs 35.20 Long By Chro 161.17 W

Saturday September 21st 1861

Comes with a strong wind from the E S E and squally at 10 AM double reefed the top Sails steering by the Wind to the S E at 6 took in jib and mainsail middle and latter part fresh Gales from the S E at midnight took in all sail except stem Sails at daylight wore ship to the Southward

Sunday September 22^d 1861

Commences with fresh Gales from the S E and good weather heading to the South under close reefed main top Sails and stay Sails at 6 PM set the Fore Sails at 9 wore ship to the and set double reefed topsails and steered N E with a strong wind from the S E at 10 AM set whole top Sails

Lat by Obs 34.15 Long By Chro 159.49 W

Monday September 23^d 1861

Commences with a strong wind from the S E and good weather steering N E at 6 PM double reefed the top Sails and haled on the wind to the Eastward middle part moderate breeze lat part light air from the S W steering N E W

Lat By Obs 33.36 Long By Chro 158.53 W

Tuesday September 24th 1861

Comes with light wind from the W and fine weather on the wind to the N E W middle part strong wind from the W S W latter part fresh Gales wore ship and steered S by W at 10 double reefed the top Sails saw nothing this day

Lat by Obs 32.39 S.

Wednesday September 25th 1861

Commences with fresh Gales from the W S W and squally steering S by W at 4 took in all sail except close reefed main top Sails at 6 PM more moderate set the Fore Sails and Mizzen top Sails close reefed heading by the wind to the S middle part strong wind latter part fresh Gales steering S with double reefed top Sails set saw nothing this day except birds plenty of them
