

Sunday October 6th 1861

Comes with a fresh breeze from the W and haze weather steering by the wind to the E at 6 P.M. took in sail for the EIGHT middle and latter part strong breeze at daylight set all sail and steered by the wind to the E

Lat by Obs 35.14 W

Monday October 7th 1861

Commences with a strong breeze from the W and cloudy steering by the wind to the S W at 6 P.M. double reefed the Top Sails middle and latter part fresh Gales from the S W heading to S W at meridian took in the Fore topsail

Lat by Obs 37.00 Long by Chro 160.36

Tuesday October 8th 1861

Comes with fresh gales from the W and good weather laying under storm sails heading to the S W at 6 P.M. wore ship to the S middle part more moderate to wind hauled to the S at daylight set all sail and steered by the wind to the westward

Lat by Obs 38.50 Long 161.15 W

Wednesday October 9th 1861

Commences with light breeze from the S and good weather steering by the wind to the W middle and latter part light baffling air with Calms Clear weather

Lat by Obs 38.19 Long by Chro 162.19

Thursday October 10th 1861

Commences with light breeze from the S and fine weather steering W saw several Suffer Bottoms middle part strong wind and thick weather at midnight double reefed the Top Sails and took in Jib and mainsail latter fresh Gales steering W with the wind from the S saw a number of Ben Backs

Lat by Obs 37.55 Long by Chro 160.09

Friday October 11th 1861

Commences with fresh Gales from the S and Cloudy weather steering W with double reefed Top Sails at 6 Am took in all sail except close reefed main Top Sail and staysails middle part rose moderate with rain latter part light wind thick and rainy steering to the westward at 10 A.M. set all sail

Lat by Obs 38.04 Long by Chro 166.15

Saturday October 12th 1861

Comes with a light air from the W with fog steering to the S W at 9 P.M. Clear at 6 calm at 10 P.M. light breeze from the S E steering S E latter light wind with thick and rainy weather

Sunday October 13th 1861

Comes with a light breeze from the S E and thick weather steering S E at 6 P.M. steered E the wind from the S middle part light air from the W latter part from the S steering S E

Lat by Obs 39.52 Long by Chro 163.15

Monday October 14th 1861

Commences with light air from the S W and good weather steering S E at 6 P.M. wind from the S steering E middle and latter part light winds with fog steering by the wind to the S E wind from the S

Lat by Obs 39.47 Long by Chro 162.51

Tuesday October 15th 1861

Comes with light breeze from the S and Cloudy steering by the wind the S at 3 P.M. tacked ship to the Southward middle and latter part light baffling air and Calms with fog working ship to the E

Wednesday October 16th 1861

Commences with Calm and foggy at 2 P.M. light air from the S E heading by the wind to the Eastward at 6 P.M. light air from the S E and rainy ship heading S E middle part wind from the S steering E latter part strong wind with thick rainy weather wind from the S W steering S E at 10 A.M. took in Top Gallant Sails
