

Saturday December 11th 1862

Comes with a strong wind from the W and cloudy steering by the wind to the S W at 2 P.M. set Jib and mainsail at 5 set all sail at 8 more ship to the S W middle and latter part strong wind from W to S W steering by the W to the S and mistral saw a number of Fin Backs

Sunday December 12th 1862

Commences with a strong wind from the W W and good weather steering by the W to the S W with Top Sails set at 4 set main Top gallant sail wind from the W middle part fresh Gales and squally at midnight double reefed the Top Sails latter part fresh gales with squalls at 6 Book in Jib and Mainsail at 4 A.M. more ship to the S W large sea running

Monday January 13th 1862

Commences with fresh gales from W S W and hazy steering by the wind to the S W with close reefed Top Sails at 2 more moderate set Jib and Mainsail at 7 wind and weather the same middle part strong Gales with rain latter part much rain at midnight Book in all but storm Sails at 6 A.M. set close reefed Fore and Mizzen Top Sails at 10 more ship to the W S W wind from the S W

Tuesday January 14th 1862

Comes with fresh Gales from the S W and fine weather steering by the wind to the W S W with close reefed Top Sails at 2 more moderate set the Jib and mainsail at 4 turned one reef out of the Top Sails middle part more moderate set all sail latter part fresh breeze from the W S W and fine weather steering by the wind to the S W employed repairing Old Sails

Lat By Obs 45. 06 Long By Chro 167. 00

Wednesday January 15th 1862

Comes with strong wind from the W S W and squally with rain steering by the wind to the S W at 4 heavy squalls double reefed the Top Sails at 6 took in the main sail middle part more moderate set the Jib and mainsail latter part fresh Gales from the W and good weather steering by the wind to the S W at 8 set whole main Top sail and double reefed Fore and Mizzen

Lat by Obs 43. 31 Long By Chro 167. 48

Thursday January 16th 1862

Commences with a fresh Gale from the W and good weather steering by the wind to the S W at 4 strong gales close reefed the Top Sails at 6 Book in Jib and mainsail at 7 took in fore and Mizzen Top Sails blowing strong Gale middle part more moderate at 2 A.M. set close reefed Fore and Mizzen Top Sails at 4 set mainsail Jib and Spanker latter part fresh breeze at 7 set whole Top Sails at 10 set Top Gallant Sails

Lat By Obs 41. 59 Long by Chro 168. 18

Friday January 17th 1862

Comes with light wind from the W and fine weather steering by the wind to the S at 3 P.M. backed to the S W at 7 light wind from the S W with a very large sea from the S middle and latter part strong wind and hazy at 4 A.M. backed ship to the S W saw nothing this day

Lat By Obs 41. 27 Long By Chro 169. 23

Saturday January 18th 1862

Commences with a strong wind from the W and good weather steering by the wind to the S at 2 P.M. backed ship to the S W middle part the same latter part moderate breeze from the S W steering by the wind to the W with all sail set

Lat by Obs 41. 46 Long by Chro 170. 50

Sunday January 19th 1862

Comes with light breeze from the S W and fine weather steering by the wind to the W middle part light wind from the S W steering by the wind to the S W heading W weather fine
