Commences with a strong Gale from the ESE and Cloudy heading by the wind to the S under storm Sails at 3 P.M. set close reefed Top Sails at 6 more ship to the SE middle part more moderate set double reefed topsails latter part strong winds from the SE and Cloudy steering by the wind to the ESE at 10 P.M. set whole topsails

Friday Feb 28th 1862

Comes with strong wind from the SE and Cloudy steering by the wind to the ESE under whole Top Sails middle part the same at 6 backed ship to the S latter part strong wind from the ESE and good weather at 11 A.M. double reefed the Top Sails employed repairing Old Sails

Saturday March 1st 1862

Comes with strong wind from the ESE and good weather steering by the wind to the S with double reefed top Sails set middle and latter part the same

Sunday March 2^d 1862

Comes with strong wind from the SE and Cloudy steering by the wind to the S at 8 took in mainsail at 11 P.M. close reefed the Top Sails and more ship to the SE middle part strong Gales at 11 took in all sail but storm Sails latter part strong gales and squally heading to the SE

Monday March 3^d 1862

Comes with strong Gales from the SE and rainy heading to the E under storm Sails middle part more moderate set close reefed Topsails latter part strong winds and squally with rain at daylight set Jib and Spanker steering by the wind to the ESE

Tuesday March 4th 1862

Commences with strong wind from the S and squally with rain steering by the wind to the ESE at 6 P.M. took in Jib and Spanker middle part more moderate latter part fresh breeze and fine weather at daylight set all sail and steered by the wind to the ESE employed in fitting Boats

Wednesday March 5th 1862

Comes with strong wind from the S squally rainy weather at 2 P.M. took in Top Gallant sails at 6 took in sail for the Slight first part steering by the wind to the ESE at 9 P.M. more ship to the Westward middle part strong wind and squally with much rain at 6 more ship to the Eastward latter part fresh gales with rain at 10 A.M. took in all sail and lay to the E blowing hard

Thursday March 6th 1862

Commences with a strong Gale from the S with rain heading to the E under storm Sails at 2 more moderate and clear at 6 strong wind at 1 P.M. wind halled to the SE at daylight strong winds from the S set double reefed Top Sails and steered by the wind to the S
Lat By Obs 31. 48 Long By Chron 178. 15 W

Friday March 7th 1862

Begins with strong wind from the SE and fine weather steering E by S at 3 P.M. halled on the wind to the WSW middle and latter part strong wind and fine weather at midnight tacked ship to the S at daylight set whole Top Sails at 10 A.M. backed to the S wind from the WSW
Lat By Obs 31. 32 Long By Chron 178. 27 W

Saturday March 8th 1862

Comes with fresh breeze from the WSW and fine weather steering by the wind to the SW at 2 tacked ship to the S wind from the WSW middle part calm latter light airs and fine weather steering by the wind to the WSW wind from the SW
