

Wednesday April 2^d 1862

Commences with strong Gale from the ESE and squally steering by the wind to the SE with close reefed Bop Sails middle part more moderate latter part strong wind from the E and fine weather at 6 set all sail and steered to the S 4 Sails in sight at meridian French Rock E 15 miles distant
Lat by Obs 31.21 Long by Chron 179.15

Thursday April 3^d 1862

Comes with a strong breeze from the SE and fine weather steering by the wind to the SE four ships in sight to the W French Rock at sunset 99 20 miles distant middle and latter part light airs from the E at daylight set all sail to the S two ships in sight at meridian French Rock S 17 20 miles distant
Lat by Obs 31.05

Friday April 4th 1862

Comes with a light air from the eastward and fine weather steering S 77 at 6 P.M. halled on the wind to the SE the hook to the ESE 15 miles one ship to the W middle part moderate breeze latter part strong breeze from the ESE and fine weather steering by the wind to the SE two ships in sight at meridian French Rock S 77 20 miles distant
Lat by Obs 31.08 Long by Chron 178.31

Saturday April 5th 1862

Comes with a strong breeze from the ESE and fine weather steering by the wind to the SE with all sail set two ships in sight at 6 P.M. double reefed the Bop Sails middle and latter part light baffling wind with squalls of rain at daylight set all sail and steered S 77
Lat by Obs 31.29

Sunday April 6th 1862

Comes with fresh breeze from the SE and squally steering S 77 One ship in sight at sunset French rock S 77 18 miles distant took in sail and halled on the wind to the E middle and latter part fresh breeze from the SE and fine weather steering S 77 at meridian Curtis Rocks 77 10 miles distant one ship in sight

Monday April 7th 1862

Commences with moderate breeze from the SE and fine weather steering SESE One ship in sight at sunset East Island 77 15 miles took in sail for the night and halled on the wind to the SE middle part light wind latter part fresh breeze from the SE at daylight set all sail and steered by the wind to the SESE at 6 P.M. Macaulay Island S 77 25 miles distant Sunday Island S 87 27
Lat by Obs 29.34

Tuesday April 8th 1862

Comes with fresh breeze from the SESE and cloudy steering by the wind to the SE at 2 took in Bop Gallant sails at 4 strong wind double reefed the Bop Sails at 6 P.M. took in Foresail Jib and spanker and wore ship to the Eastward Sunday Is E 88 45 miles distant middle part fresh gales and squally at midnight took in fore and Mizzen Bop Sails latter part strong Gales with rain heading to the Eastward under storm sails
Lat by Obs 29.44 Long by Chron 177.58

Wednesday April 9th 1862

Commences with strong Gales from the SE and squally at 2 more moderate at 3 set the foresail at 4 set fore and Mizzen Bop Sails heading by the wind to the Eastward middle part fresh Gales from the SESE and good weather latter part strong Gales at 8 Am took in Bare Sail Fore and Mizzen Bop Sails
Lat by Obs 29.34

Thursday April 10th 1862

Commences with strong Gales from the SE and clear laying under storm sails to the Eastward at 3 squally with rain at 6 rather more moderate middle and latter part fresh gales and fine weather at daylight set double reefed Bop sails at 9 set the Jib at 9 wore ship to the S wind from the S 79 77
Lat by Obs 29.03 Long by Chron 176.33
