

Friday May 9th 1862

Commences with a strong wind from the S E and good weather steering by the wind heading E S E with double reefed top Gails One ship in sight at dark took in sail and wore ship to the S middle part strong wind latter part more moderate at daylight set whole top Gails and steered by the wind to the E S E one ship in sight to the S

Lat By Obs 23.36 Long By Chro 171.15 W

Saturday May 10th 1862

Comes with strong breeze from the S E and good weather steering by the wind to the E S E with all sail set at dark took in sail for the night middle and latter part strong winds at daylight set double reefed top sail and steered by the wind to the E S E at 8 saw a ship to the S W supposed to be a whaling run for her at noon still running for the ship

Lat By Obs 23.02 Long by Chro 171.29

Sunday May 11th 1862

Comes with strong breeze from the S E and good weather steering W S W for the ship at 2 came up with her and found she was not a whaling halled the wind to the E S E at dark wore ship to the S and took in sail middle and latter part strong wind from the S E at midnight wore ship to the E at daylight set whole top sail and steered by the wind to the E saw nothing this day

Monday May 12th 1862

Comes with strong wind from the S E and good weather steering by the wind to the E middle part strong wind from the S E and squally latter part fresh breeze and fine weather steering by the wind to the S E

Lat by Obs 22.23 Long By Chro 168.01

Tuesday May 13th 1862

Comes with moderate breeze from the S E and fine weather steering by the wind to the S E middle and latter part light breeze from the E and fine weather steering by the wind to the S E

Lat By Obs 21.56 Long By Chro 176.59

Wednesday May 14th 1862

Comes with light air from the E and fine weather steering by the wind to the S at 5 P M cept off S W middle part light baffling air latter light air from the S E steering by the wind to the S W

Lat By Obs 21.33 Long By Chro 167.26

Thursday May 15th 1862

Comes with light air from the S E steering by the wind to the S W with all sail set saw nothing of note middle and latter part light breeze from the S E and fine weather steering S W with all sail set

Lat By Obs 21.47 Long By Chro 168.34

Friday May 16th 1862

Commences with a strong breeze from the S E and fine steering S W with all sail set middle and latter part strong wind from the E and cloudy steering S W with all sail set

Lat By Obs 23.34 Long by Chro 171.26

Saturday May 17th 1862

Commences with strong wind from the E and cloudy steering S W by S with all sail set middle part squally with thunder and lightning wind halled to the S W took in top Gallant Gails latter part strong wind from the W at 8 A M wore ship and steered by the wind to the S S W with main top Gallant Gail set

Lat by Obs 24.38 Long By Chro 173.32

Sunday May 18th 1862

Comes with strong wind from the W and fine steering by the wind to the S S W with main top Gallant sail set at 6 P M set all sail middle part light air latter part light air and calm ship heading to all points of the Compass one ship in sight

Lat by Obs 23.02 Long By Chro 173.56

Monday May 19th 1862

Comes with calm one ship in sight to the E at 6 light air from the S E heading to the S W at 5 A M moderate breeze from the W S W latter part fresh breeze and fine steering by the wind to the S Lat by Obs 22.03 Long By Chro 175.15
