

Monday June 23rd 1862

Commences with strong Gales from the E and squally steering
S under close reefed Top Gails middle part the same latter
part squally at 7 AM set the main sail and steered S by W
at meridian took in the main sail

Lat by Obs 22.22 Long by Chro 172.31

Tuesday June 24th 1862

Comes with strong Gales from the E and squally steering
S by W with close reefed Top Gails at 3 PM took all sail
except Storm Gails and hove too to the S middle and latter
part strong Gales with a Mad sea

Lat by Obs 22.58 Long by Chro 172.31

Wednesday June 25th 1862

Commences with strong Gales from the E and squally
headdng to the Southward under storm sails middle
part the same latter part moderate Gales

Lat by Obs 23.07 Long by Chro 172.21

Thursday June 26th 1862

Comes with a moderate Gale from the E & E and good
weather headdng to the SE with storm sails set
middle part more moderate at midnight set the Bore
sail at 4 AM set the Bore and mizen topsails close
reefed at daylight set whole topsails and steered
S by W strong winds from the SE and good weather

Lat by Obs 23.45 Long by Chro 172.44

Friday June 27th 1862

Comes with a strong wind from the SE and fine weather
steering S by W with main Top Gallant sail set
at dark double reefed the Top sails and steered W by W
middle part strong breeze latter part moderate breeze
and fine weather at daylight set all sail and steered
S by W employed repairing Boat

Lat by Obs 24.45 Long by Chro 174.50

Saturday 28 June 1862

Commences with a moderate breeze from the SE and good
weather steering S by W at sunset took in sail and halled
On the wind to the Eastward middle part wind and weather
the same as the first at midnight wore ship to the SE at 6
AM Squally double reefed the top sails and steered S by W
at 9 good weather set all sail and steered S by W

Lat by Obs 25.18 Long by Chro 175.26

Sunday June 29th 1862

Commences with a moderate breeze from the SE and
hazy steering S by W with all sail set at dark thick and
raining with thunder and lightning took in sail and halled
On the wind to the W wind SE by W middle part squally
with rain at midnight wore ship to the SE latter part
light air from the W steering to the SE with all sail set

Lat by Obs 25.18 Long by Chro 175.41

Monday June 30th 1862

Commences with a light breeze from the S by W and fine weather
steering S with all sail set at dark took in sail fore the
night and halled on the wind to the E & E mini to the S
middle part the same latter part moderate breeze from the SE
and fine weather steering by the wind to the E & E saw one finned

Lat by Obs 25.18 Long by Chro 174.33

Tuesday June 31st 1862

Comes with a fresh breeze from the SE and fine weather steering
by the wind to the E & E at dark took in sail and wore ship
to the S by W middle part the same latter part strong winds
from the E and fine weather at daylight set all sail and
steered S by W

Lat by Obs 25.38 Long by Chro 175.50

Wednesday July 2^d 1862

Comes with strong breeze from the E and good weather steering
W by W with all sail set at sunset took in sail and steered by the
wind to the S latter part light wind from the SE steering by the
wind to the SE Lat by Obs 24.45 Long by Chro 174.50
