

Sunday August 10th 1862

Commences with strong Gale from the west with squalls of rain
laying under storm sails to the S a bad sea running at dusk
rather more moderate at midnight set double reefed Top Sails
wind from WNW at 6 AM wore ship to the S at meridian set
whole top Sails and main sail

Lat by Obs 28. 23 Long by Chro 168. 55

Monday August 11th 1862

Commences with a strong Wind from the WNW and heavy steamer
by the wind to the S at 6 PM double reefed the Top Sails and
furled the main sail middle and latter part fresh Gales with
squally weather steering by the wind to the S

Lat by Obs 28. 42 Long by Chro 169. 18

Tuesday August 12th 1862

Comes with fresh Gales from the SW and squally steering
by the wind to the SE under double reefed at 6 wind from
the SW at 6 wore ship to the W middle part more moderate
latter part fresh breeze WNW at 3 AM set whole top Sails
at 8 set the Top Gallant sails at 10 wind hauled to the WNW
tacked ship to the S at 9 saw Norfolk Island S W

Wednesday August 13th 1862

Commences with a fresh breeze from the W and good weather
steering by the wind to the Southward wind hailing gradual
to the S at 6 PM wind SW by S heading W by S took
in top gallant Sails at 8 PM double reefed the Top Sails at
midnight took in fore and mizen top Sails and close reefed
the main strong Gales from the W latter part the same

Lat by Obs 30. 03 Long by Chro 168. 19

Thursday Aug 14th 1862

Comes with strong Gales from the W and squally lay
under storm Sails to the S at 3 PM rather more moderate
set close reefed topsails steering by the wind to the S
a bad sea running

Lat by Obs 30. 18 Long by Chro 168. 25

Friday August 15th 1862

Commences with a fresh Gale from the SW and good weather
steering by the wind with close reefed Top Sails set at 4 set the
crossed Jib and spanker at 6 set double reefed Top sails large
sea on at 10 PM set whole Top Sails at 6 AM set all sail
steering by the wind heading SW by W latter part light
wind from the South and Westward at 6 AM saw Norfolk
Island S 20 miles distant at meridian Lat 28 E by E

Lat by Obs 29. 08 Long by Chro 169. 06

Saturday August 16th 1862

Commences with a light breeze from the WNW and fine weather
steering by the wind to the SW at 4 PM wore ship to the
S at sunset the land E by S 10 leagues distant middle part
squally took in Top Gallant Sails latter part strong winds from
the SW steering by the wind to the SW

Lat by Obs 29. 58 Long by Chro 168. 25

Sunday August 17th 1862

Comes with fresh breeze from the SW steering by the wind to
the SW at 5 PM set all sail. wind light middle part strong
breeze from the WNW heading SW latter part fresh Gales
at 5 AM double reefed the Top Sails at 8 close reefed the
topsails and took in Jib and cross fresh gales and squally

Lat by Obs 31. 18 Long by Chro 165. 57

Monday Aug 18th 1862

Commences with fresh Gales from the WNW and squally
steering by the wind to the SW with close reefed topsails set
at 5 PM set the fore sail middle and latter part fresh Gales
and squally steering by the wind to the S under double reefed

Lat by Obs 32. 18 Long by Chro 166. 01

Tuesday August 19th 1862

Comes with fresh Gales from the WNW and squally heading
to the S with double reefed Top Sails set at 6 wind from SW wore
ship to WNW middle and latter part fresh breeze steering by
the wind to the westward with all sail set
