

Saturday August 30th 1862

Commences with a fresh Gale from the S and good weather steering by the wind to the N with double reefed Topsails at 6 PM wore ship to the Eastward middle part the same latter part moderate breeze from the S E at 5 AM set all sail and steered by the wind to the S W saw a number Fin Backs
Lat By Obs 34.15 Long By Chro 152.49

Sunday August 31st 1862

Comes with light airs from the S E and fine weather steering by the wind to the S W with all sail set middle part light air from the S heading S latter part light air from the S E heading S W at 2 AM saw a steamer to the W at meridian 2 sail in sight to the S W

Monday August 32nd 1862

Comes with light airs from the S W and good weather steering S W at 2 sent a Boat on Board the Bremen Bark Creole to get some papers she left Sydney yesterday with Coal Bound to Shanghai reports the Ship Stephano to the S W boiling at 3 PM saw the Ship boiling at 4 calm middle part light breeze from the S steering S W by S latter part fresh breeze from the S E steering S W several sail in sight at daylight the land in sight

Tuesday September 2nd 1862

Comes with a strong breeze from the S E and good weather steering S W. S and S E at 3 PM spoke the Bark Stephania of N Bedford Boiling. went on Board and got some papers at 4 went back and steered S by E middle part strong wind from the S running under three Top Sails latter part fresh breeze at daylight set the Fore sail and Main Top Gallant sail and steered S at meridian steered S W

Wednesday Sept 3rd 1862

Comences with fresh breeze from the S and fine weather steering S W by W at dark took in sail for the night and wore ship to the E middle and latter part strong breeze at daylight set whole top Sails and steered by the wind to the S W

Thursday Sept 4th 1862

Comes with a strong breeze from the S and good weather steering S E at 3 PM saw rite whales roved the Boat saw the whales but once after the boat lored at 5 took the Boat up and took in sail and headed to the E middle and latter part strong winds from the S and hazy at daylight set double reefed topsails and steered by the wind to the S W at 10 AM saw Cape 15 miles distant at 11 steered E

Friday Sept 5th 1862

Comes with a strong wind from the S and hazy weather steering E saw fin Backs at dark took in sail and heeled to the wind to the S E middle part fresh breeze latter part light breeze from the S and fine weather steering by the wind to the Eastward with all sail set
Lat by Obs 37.16 Long By Chro 151.45

Saturday Sept 6th 1862

Commences with a light breeze from the S and fine weather steering to the Eastward with all sail set at dark took in sail for the night and finished setting at daybreak middle part moderate breeze latter part light breeze from the S E steering by the wind to the Southward at meridian tack to the S E
Lat by Obs 37.31

Sunday Sept 7th 1862

Comes with moderate breeze from E and cloudy steering by the wind to the S at dark took in sail for the night and wore ship to the S E middle and latter part strong winds from the S E at daylight set double reefed topsails and steered by the wind to the Eastward saw a ship to the S
