Commences with strong winds from the W & W and squally with rain at 10 A.M. double reefed Top Gails at dark took in sail for the night and headed to the S at 3 P.M. passed a ship middle and latter part fresh breeze from the W and good weather at daylight set all sail and steered to the S saw nothing this day

Friday November 7<sup>th</sup> 1862  
Comes with a light air from the S & W and fine weather steering by the wind to the S & W at dark took in sail heading S middle and latter part strong breeze from the S & W and happy at daylight set whole top Gails and steered by the wind to the W & W

Saturday November 8<sup>th</sup> 1862  
Commences with strong wind from the S & W and happy steering by the wind to the W & W with Top Gails set at sun set took in Gail middle and latter part fresh wind from the S and cloudy at daylight set whole top sails and steered by the wind to the W & W at 10 A.M. steered S E by S  
Lat By Obs 39.11 Long By Chro 153.45

Sunday November 9<sup>th</sup> 1862  
Comes with a strong wind from the S and cloudy steering S E by S at 3 wind halled to W & W at sunset took in sail and halled on the wind to the S middle and latter part wind from the W at daylight set all sail and steered S E at 10 A.M. lored for a whale at meridian the boat in chase of a whale

Monday Nov 10<sup>th</sup> 1862  
There 24 hours a moderate breeze from the S and fine first part steering E at dark took in sail at daylight set all sail and steered S E at 10 A.M. lored for a whale at meridian Boat in chase of a whale

Tuesday November 11<sup>th</sup> 1862  
Commences with moderate breeze from the S and fine the Boat in chase of a whale at 2 took the Boat up at 3 lored for a whale and chased until dark could not get fast took the Boat up and took in sail for the night ship heading W & W middle part cloudy latter part strong winds and thick rainy weather at daylight set whole topsails at 8 A.M. double reefed the Top Gails and steered by the wind to the S & W wind from the W  
Lat by Obs 40.15

Wednesday November 12<sup>th</sup> 1862  
Commences with light breeze from the W and foggy steering by the wind to the S at 5 P.M. fine weather at sunset took in sail middle part fresh breeze latter part strong wind from the S & W and good weather at daylight set double reefed Top Gails and steered by the wind to the S E at 9 saw a whale lored saw no more of him took the boat up

Thursday November 13<sup>th</sup> 1862  
Comes with a fresh breeze from the S and fine set whole topsails and steered W & W at 2 P.M. set all sail at sun set took in sail for the night middle part wind halled to the S & W latter part fresh breeze and good weather at daylight set whole Topsails and steered by the wind to the S & W saw many Pinbacks at meridian steered S E by E  
Lat By Obs 40.10 Long By Chro 155.11

Friday November 14<sup>th</sup> 1862  
Commences with a moderate breeze from the S & W and fine steering by the compass S E by E at 3 P.M. at dark took in sail and headed to the S & W middle part the wind and weather much the same latter part strong wind from the S at daylight set whole top Gails and Main top gallant sail and steered S & W at 10 A.M. double reefed Top Gails and halled the wind to the W & W saw plenty Pinbacks.
