

Saturday November 15th 1862

Commences with fresh Gale from the S and Clear at 10 AM took in the main Sail Rib and Spanker at 2 took in Fore and Mizzen Top Sails at 4 PM took in Fore Sail and Close reefed the main Top Sail and wore ship to the E middle part strong Gale wind halled gradually to the W at daylight fresh breeze and heavy sea set all sail and steered by the wind to the S saw many Fin Backs

Sunday November 16th 1862

Comes with light breeze from the W and fine weather steering by the wind to the S at dark took in sail middle and latter part light breeze and fine weather at daylight set all sail and steered by the wind to the S

Monday November 17th 1862

Commences with light breeze from the W and good weather steering by the wind to the S at dark took in sail middle part light breeze wind halled to the S at daylight set all sail and steered by the wind to the W S W

Tuesday November 18th 1862

Comes with fresh breeze from the S and fine steering W S W at 2 PM saw a sail to the S at dark took in sail middle part fresh breeze latter part moderate Gale and squally at daylight set double reefed topsails and steered W

Wednesday Nov 20th 1862

Commences with a light baffling breeze and squally with rain saw a ship to the S middle part light breeze at daylight Calm set all sail at 8 AM light breeze and and Cloudy steering S at meridian spoke the Illinois Capt Potter 1000 spdm 1000 Whale went On Board

Thursday November 20th 1862

Commences with moderate breeze from the S and foggy at 6 PM took in sail middle and latter part strong breeze from the S and hazy at daylight set double reefed Top Sails and steered S E the ship Illinois in company saw Fin Backs

Friday November 21st 1862

Comes with a strong wind from the S W and misty steering S E with double reefed Top Sails the Illinois in company at 7 PM took in sail for the night middle and latter part wind from the W at daylight set double reefed topsails and steered S E weather Clear large sea

Lat By Obs 40.12 Long By Chron 156.23

Saturday November 22nd 1862

Commences with strong winds from the W and Clear steering S E with double reefed topsails at 5 PM saw two rite whales local three Boats could not get fast took the Boats up and took in sail heading to the S S W middle and latter part strong winds and Clear at daylight set double reefed topsails and steered by the wind to the S at 11 AM wore ship to the S

Sunday November 23rd 1862

Commences with fresh breeze from the S W and hazy steering S at 2 PM set whole main Top Sail and steered S E at 4 took in sail and halled on the wind to the S S W the Illinois in sight middle and latter part fresh breeze and good weather at daylight set all sail and steered S E the Illinois in sight

Lat By Obs 41.06 Long By Chron 157.57

Monday Nov 24th 1862

Comes with a moderate breeze and cloudy steering S E at 2 PM spoke the Illinois at dark took in sail for the night heading E S E wind from the S middle and latter part strong wind from the S and raining with thunder and lightning laying under short sail to the West
