close reefed middle part fresh Gale latter part strong wind from the
W. S. W. with passing squalls. at daylight set double reefs and steered
by the wind to the S. W. saw several Pinbacks

Monday December 15th 1862

Comes with strong winds from the W. S. W. and good weather
with a heavy swell from the S. at 10 P.M. wore ship and steered
by the wind to the S. at 2 P.M. set whole Top Sails at 3 set Top
Gallant sails at 7 P.M. wore ship and took in sail for the night
middle and latter part fresh breeze and fine weather wind from
the W. S. W. at daylight set all sail and steered by the wind to
the S. W. saw several Pinbacks

Comes with fresh Breeze from the S. W. and foul at 3 P.M.
squally with rain at 5 wind from the W. S. W. and cloudy
at sunset took in sail heading S. middle and latter part
fresh breeze and good weather at daylight set all sail and
steered by the wind to the S. W. at 11 A.M. saw a ship
to the N. steering to the Eastward

Wednesday December 17th 1862

Commences with a strong breeze from the W. and passing
squalls of rain at 3 P.M. spoke the Ship Hunter
Capt Bessy with 2000 bls Oil 2300 Sperm & 500 Whl
Oil capt came On Board. steering by the wind to the S. W.
at sunset took in sail for the night at daylight
strong Breeze from the S. W. set whole Top Sails
and steered by the wind to the S. E. the Hunter
set Top Sails and stood Out of sight to the S. W.
latter part some what squally

Thursday December 18th 1862

Commences with strong winds from the S. W. and squally steering
by the wind to the S. E. at 4 P.M. saw a sail to the S. at 6 P.M. the
red Signals with an English Bark at 7 P.M. took in sail and
wore ship to the W. S. W. middle and latter part strong breeze
and squally at daylight set double reefed Top Sails and steered
by the wind to the S. W. at 10 A.M. set all sail at meridian
wore ship to the S. E. saw several Pinbacks

Comes with strong breeze from the S. W. and longay steering
by the wind to the S. E. at dark wore ship to the W. and took
in sail middle and latter part moderate winds from the W.

steered by the wind to the S. W. saw several Pinbacks

Saturday December 20th 1862

Commences with strong winds from the S. W. and squally
steering by the wind to the S. E. with all sail set at 6 P.M.
spoke a English Ship steering S. W. at sunset wore
ship to the W. S. W. and took in sail for the night middle
and latter part moderate breeze from the S. W. and good
weather at daylight set all sail and steered by the wind to
the W. saw Pinbacks. at 9 A.M. saw a ship to the S.

Commences with a moderate breeze from the S. W. and good weather steering
by the wind to the W. with all
sail set at 4 P.M. saw a Bark to the W. steering to the

fresh breeze from the S. and good weather. at daylight set all sail
and steered S. W. at day light saw a sail to the S. E. saw nothing
this day
