

Friday January 9th 1863

Commences with a strong breeze from the ESE and cloudy steering by the wind to the S with all sail set at 4 P.M. took in Top Gallant Sails and wore ship to the SE middle and latter part moderate breeze from the ESE and cloudy steering by the wind to the SE with all sail set saw nothing

Saturday Jan 10th 1863

Comes with moderate breeze from the ESE and cloudy steering by the wind to the SE with all sail set at 4 P.M. light baffling wind took in sail for the night middle and latter part moderate and fine at daylight set all sail and steered by the wind to the SE

Sunday Jan 11th 1863

Commences with a strong moderate breeze from the ESE and fine clear weather steering by the wind to the SE with all sail set middle and latter part light wind and calm ship heading all points of the compass

Monday Jan 12th 1863

Comes with calm at 4 P.M. light breeze from the E heading to the SSE middle part light breeze from the E latter part fresh breeze from the ESE with light squalls of rain steering by the wind to the SSE at meridian tacked ship to the SE

Monday Jan 13th 1863

Comes with fresh breeze from the ESE and fine weather at 4 P.M. wind SE heading SW at 6 tacked to the E middle and latter part moderate breeze from the E steering by the wind to the SSE with all sail set

Lat 73 Obs 34.25 Long 73 Chro 166.57

Wednesday January 14th 1863

Commences with a strong breeze from the ESE and fine weather steering by the wind to the SE with all sail set at 2 P.M. took in Top Gallant sails middle and latter part strong wind and cloudy

Lat 73 Obs 32.48 Long 73 Chro 169.09

Thursday Jan 15th 1863

Comes with strong winds from the ESE and cloudy heavy steering by the wind to the SE at 10 P.M. double reefed Top Sails middle part strong winds with rain at 8 P.M. wore ship to the SE latter part fresh gales from the E and cloudy heavy weather steering by the wind to the SE with double reefed Top Sails set

Lat 73 Obs 33 Long 73 Chro 169.38

Friday Jan 16th 1863

Commences with moderate gales from the E and cloudy steering by the wind to the SE under double reefed Top Sails at 7 P.M. more moderate wore ship heading SE by SE and set whole Top sails middle and latter part strong wind from the E at 8 P.M. spoke the Bark of Sidney capt 7 months out Ocean at 9 tacked ship to the SE saw nothing

Lat 73 Obs 33.47 Long 73 Chro 170.12

Saturday Jan 17th 1863

Comes with strong winds from the E and good weather steering by the wind to the SE with main Top Gallant Sails set at 7 P.M. tacked to the S middle and latter part strong wind and squally ship on different tacks working to the E

Lat 73 Obs 44.06 Long 73 Chro 171.07

Sunday Jan 18th 1863

Commences with strong winds from the E and cloudy steering by the wind to the SSE with Top Sails set middle and latter part wind and weather the same as first at 4 P.M. tacked to the S at 9 o'clock 8 P.M. saw the three Kings Island bearing SE 10 leagues distant at meridian tacked ship to the S land 15 miles distant
